**Opened:** Locus clarified below cleaning locus L18436.

Limits (N) Baulk below wall W18229.

- (S) Same matrix left as a temporary walkway = L18456.
- (E) 1999 test trench (L18420 at btm), continued as L18430 in SE.
- (W) Baulk under L18441.
- **Closed:** When the temporary walkway L18456 was removed, a new locus # (L18452) was assigned to the expanded area.
- **Matrix:** Horizontal layers of sandy brown matrix, ashy grey matrix with charcoal bits and patches of ephemeral plaster surfaces.

**Relations:** L18445 is visible in baulks and sections in all directions.

- = L18430 and L18437 to E, L18456 to S, L18452 below, and L18444 to N.
- Aggregate of multiple surfaces from a sealed deposit.
- Some of the layers sloped down in the NW corner.
- Pottery baskets 186259-62 may belong with this locus rather than cleaning locus L18436 above.
- This locus was dry sieved (25 buckets). Wet sieve unavailable.

**Importance:** High value. Clearly traceable locus with moderate amount of pottery from transition LB - IA.
