**Opened:** Initially opened as a "twilight zone" parallel to wall W9140, eventually relegated to hypothetical foundation trench.

**Limits (N)** Baulk under wall W9211

(S) Excavated 1999

(E) L18454, L18453, L18443

(W) Baulk under wall W9140.

**Closed:** Excavated below wall W9140 with no conclusive evidence of a foundation trench.

**Matrix:** Sandy brown matrix with a carbonized log, plastered surfaces and ashy lenses.

**Relations:** The bottom course of of wall W9140 descends markedly towards the S. The various matrices in L18469 continue below the stones to the N and meet the stones to the W.

This locus was initially opened as a "twilight zone" in L18443. Bkts 186370/1/2 from TZ 18443 belong with L18469. No foundation trench lines were ever discerned.

**Importance:** Low value - limited extent and hypothetical context. Transition LB / IA pottery.

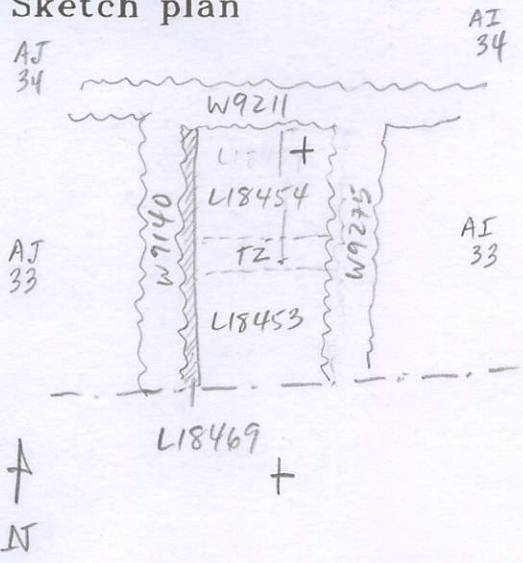
