summary:

Opened: Due to difficulties in isolating L18909 from L18910, the 2 were intentionally combined into a single mixed locus.

- Limits (N)** L18903
(S) baulk under W9066
(E) L18903
(W) baulk under W9914

Closed: distinguished L18917 and L18920 below

Matrix: Soft grey matrix with charcoal in SW (=L18909, L18920) and mixed mudbrick, phytoliths, large bones, and sherds of L18917 throughout the rest of the area.

Relations: As was the case with L18910 above, L18913 white patches and sherds slope up to meet L18903 along a nearly vertical face. The matrix in the center increasingly yields occupational debris - increasingly larger sherds and bones.

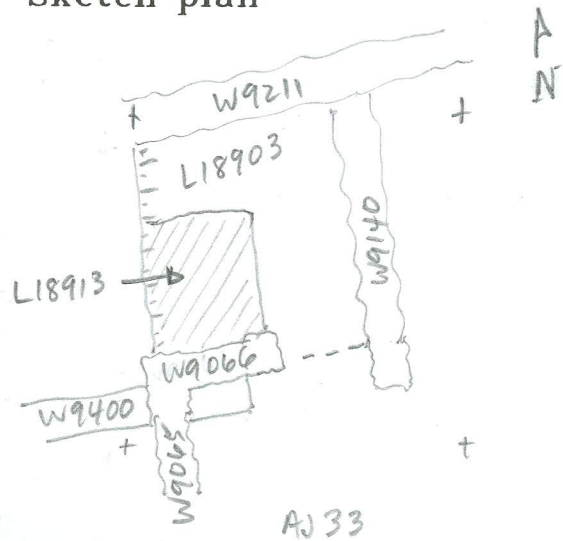
Importance: Low - intentionally mixed fills.
