**Opened:** Due to difficulties in isolating L18909 from L18910, the 2 were intentionally combined into a single mixed locus.

**Relations:** As was the case with L18910 above, L18913 white patches and sherds slope up to meet L18903 along a nearly vertical face. The matrix in the center increasingly yields occupational debris increasingly larger sherds and bones.
