Matrix: Fieldstone wall forming doorway with W9400. Consists of 5 courses. Stones range in width from approximately 9 cm to 27 cm. Contemporary with upper section of W9975. Southern extent not exposed.

Relations: W18921 (E-W) is bonded (J. Berg) to W9975 (N-S) to the west and forms a doorway with W9400 (E-W). F18901 is contemporary with the 3 walls (phase 7). Like W9400, larger stones were used at the doorway edges for stability.

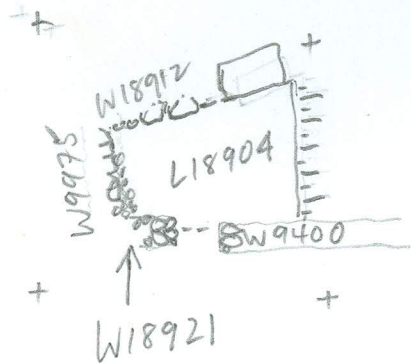
Importance: Phase 7 wall that creates a doorway into a room.
