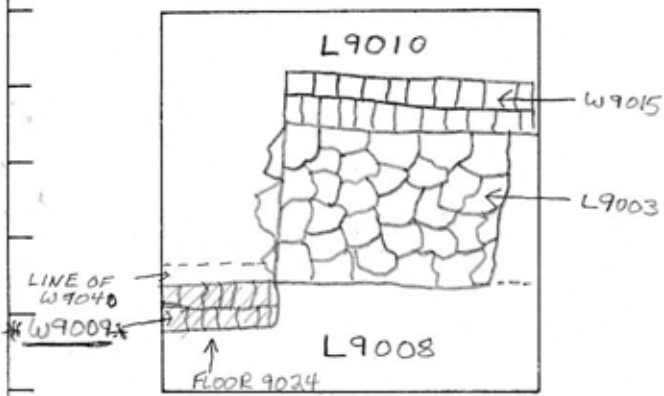

REASON FOR OPENING: STONES DEFINING THE WALL APPEARED. L9004 WAS THEN SPLIT INTO L9010 AND L9008

DEFINITION/LIMITS: WALL REACHING INTO THE WEST BAWLK DEFINED ON THE NORTH BY L9010 AND ON THE SOUTH + EAST BY L9008. ABUTS SOUTHWEST CORNER OF L9003

REASON FOR CLOSING: W9009 WAS REMOVED IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN LOWER W9040 AND FLOOR 9024, BOTH EARLIER CONSTRUCTIONS. ALSO TO ESTABLISH RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN W9040 + L9003

MATRIX: KURKAR BLOCKS (20 x 30 x 25 CM. AVE.) IN HEADER CONSTRUCTION. A SILL (FOR PAVING STONES?) WAS CUT AT A LATER DATE, POSSIBLY FOR A STREET ASSOCIATED WITH L9003

RELATIONSHIP TO OTHER ELEMENTS: W9009 IS BUILT OVER THE SOUTHERN

THIRD OF W9040. FLOOR 9003 REACHES W9009 AT LEVEL 1598, THE RELATIONSHIP TO L9003 IS UNCLEAR EXCEPT THAT W9009 IS AN EARLIER CONSTRUCTION. NO STONES WERE ATTACHED IN ANY WAY TO L9003. W9009 RESTS DIRECTLY UPON SOUTHERN THIRD OF W9040. PUBLICATION PHOTO# M7009 ON FACINGS

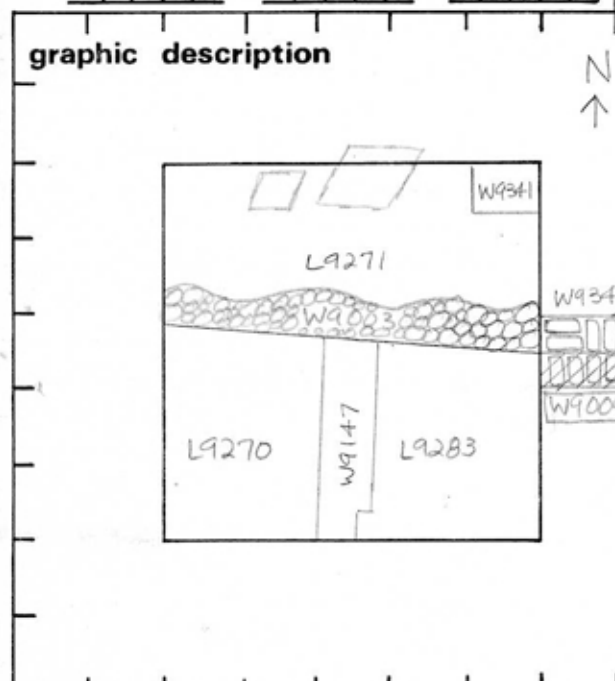

Description: Reason for Opening: Removal of E bank of AK33 revealed presence of W9009

Definition/Limits: W9009, which consists of four headers, was completely contained within the E bank of Square AK34. W9009 is bounded to the W by W9003.

Reason for Closing: Not excavated - End of Season

Relation to Other Elements: Note: Relations to Elements in Square AK33 are based on similar elevations - W9009 was completely contained within the E bank. W9009 cuts L9220 & L9242. W9009 abuts W9345.

Matrix: Header stones - average dimension: 43cm x 17cm x 26cm.
