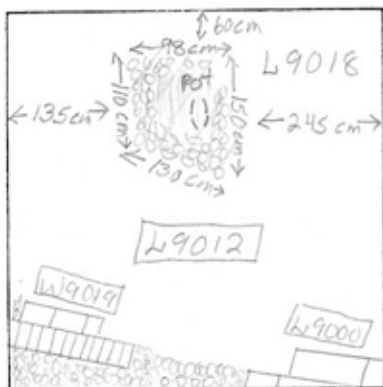

[OPENED] [L9018] was opened when the rubble seen previously in the northern part of the square was recognized as a pit.

[DEFINITION/LIMITS] [L9018] was located in the northern part of the square and was roughly trapezoidal in shape.

[CLOSED] [L9018] was closed when the bottom of the pit was reached.

[RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS] [L9018] cut through and extended beneath floor [L9012]. The pit was not recognized until rubble stones were uncovered and some were removed.

[MATRIX] [L9018] was made up of rough stones that varied in size from 10-30 cm across. The soil of [L9018] was fine and medium brown. Shards from a single pot were found embedded upright in connecting positions, and throughout the pit other sherds were found in connecting positions. All sherds from [L9018] were saved for possible restoration.

* According to elevations [L9018] was not identified as a pit until [L9012] was closed. Its upper (above opening level) material was lumped in w/ [L9012].
