

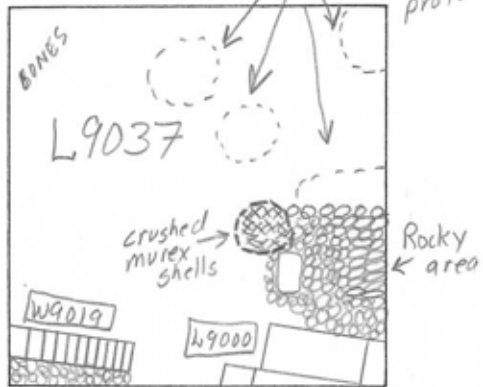

Sherds and vessels found 25-07-86 and covered with earth for protection



[OPENED] L9037 was opened when a soil matrix similar to that seen in L9031 in square AJ33 was reached.

[DEFINITION/LIMITS] L9037 extended from the north baulk southward over the entire square to the scarps on which L9000 and L9019 rest.

[CLOSED] L9037 was closed when stones began to appear in the south east corner of the square.

[RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS] L9000 and L9019 both float above the level of L9037. The Three stones extending from the east baulk about 1m south of the NE corner floated above L9037. They were removed with the architect's permission.

[MATRIX] L9037 was made up of medium brown, very sandy soil with many sherds and many bones. There were some bits of plaster and about 4 tesserae in various parts of the square. Large body sherds and some diagnostic sherds were found in connecting positions and sherds were collected for restoration. Many bones were found under large sherds in the NW part of the square. A deposit of crushed murex shells about 60cm in diameter was found near the rocky area.
