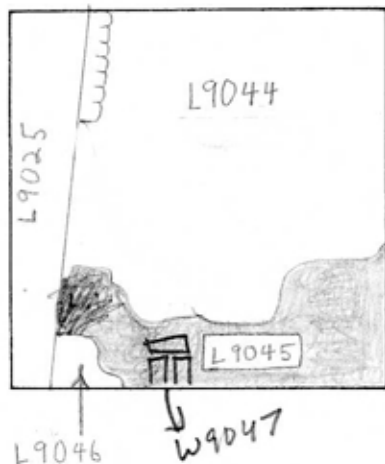

final locus no. arch. unit/logical area stage (in sq.) final STRATUM

OPENED: When top of possible wall<sup>(L9045)</sup> was reached.

DEFINED: North to L9044; east and south to baulks; south-west to L9046; west to drain L9025. Consists of large stones, some cut + field stones of varying sizes.

CLOSED: When wall (9047) was distinguished

RELATION: at end of season, it was realized that this locus masked several features + rubble fall. it seems clear that features in L9045 cut by L9044 and cut by drain 9025.
