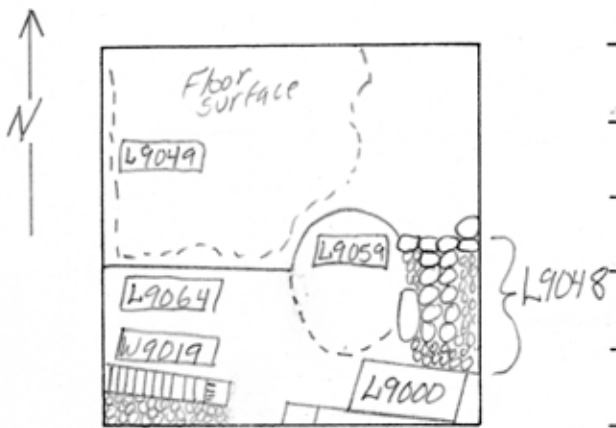

[OPENED] [L9048] was opened when a section of rough stones appeared in the southeast corner of the square.
[DEFINITION/LIMITS] [L9048] was a section of rough stones extending from the south baulk 230 cm north along the east baulk. It extended about 170 cm west of the east baulk and was somewhat irregular in shape.
[CLOSED] [L9048] was not closed at the end of the 1986 excavation season. It remains to be excavated.
[RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS] The soil of [L9049] reached the stones of [L9048]. As [L9048] remains unexcavated at this time, the possible relationships between [L9048] and the other loci ([L9059] and floor [L9049]) can not be determined.

[MATRIX] [L9049] is made up of rough field stones of up to 40 cm across. The binding soil is medium brown and sandy. Some bones and sherds were found in the process of defining the stones. Some of the stones appeared to be laid along a line, but further excavation will be needed to determine whether [L9048] might be a rough wall.
