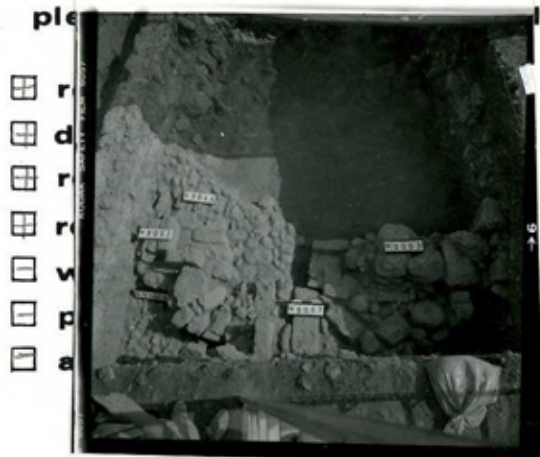
OPENED: To distinguish features inside L9045.

Definition: Upon opening to east and south by baulks, to west by w.9047, to north-west and north by L9050. Upon closing L9053 was reduced in size by the separating out of Loci: w.9058 to the west and L.9062 to the south. L9063 replaced L9050 by closing date. Consists of rocks and fill.

CLOSED: End of season. 18.07.91. locus → CHANGE L9053 becomes part of W9058. JPN [9052, 9053, 9068] = 9058

RELATION: Originally [9053] reached [9047] / [9044]. It did not reach floor [9044]. Upon removal of obvious rubble walls 9058 was uncovered.

It seems possible that some at least of the large fieldstones in [L9053] may have comprised rubble between ashlar piers w.9058 and 9068 in + proposed pier and rubble wall.
