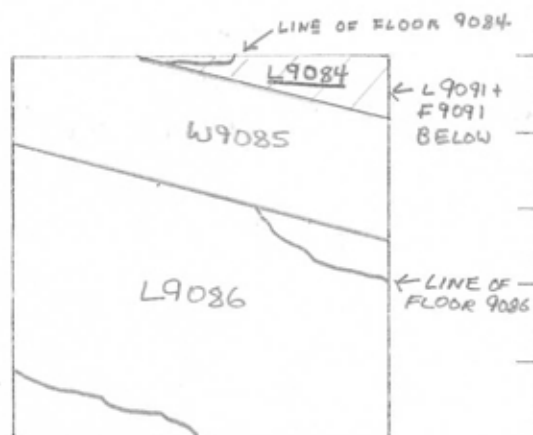

OPENED: UPON DISCOVERY OF W9085

DEFINITION/LIMITS: SECTION ALONG THE NORTH OF W9085, HITS N/E BALK

MATRIX: DARK BROWN TOPSOIL WITH CHUNKS OF KURKAR, BROKEN CONCRETE + PLASTER. FLOOR OF BADLY DAMAGED PLASTER.

REASON FOR CLOSING: REACHED FRAGMENTARY REMAINS OF A FLOOR.

ONLY VISIBLE IN A SMALL SECTION OF THE NORTH BALK.

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: FLOOR 9084 WAS SO POORLY PRESERVED

IT WAS IMPOSSIBLE TO TELL WHETHER IT REACHED W9085. ON THE BASIS OF LEVEL, HOWEVER, IT SEEMS LIKELY THAT IT REPRESENTS A FLOOR, OR A LEVEL OF SUB-FLOOR THAT WAS ORIGINALLY ASSOCIATED WITH W9085.

THIS FLOOR IS 15 CMS. HIGHER THAN FLOOR 9091, AND THE SAME DISTANCE ABOVE F9086. IT SEEMS LIKELY THAT FLOOR 9091 AND FLOOR 9086 ARE

CONTEMPORARY AND THAT FLOOR 9084 REPRESENTS A LATER RESURFACING.
