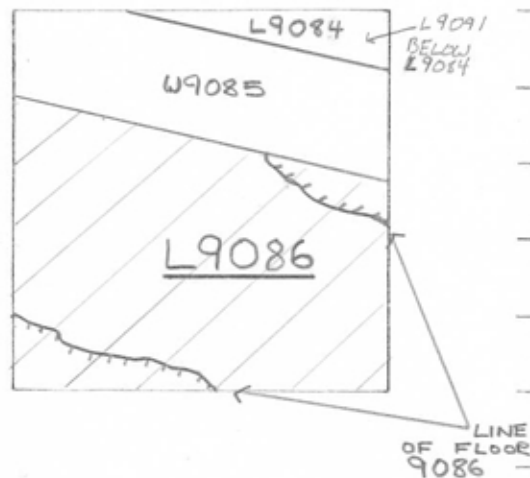

OPENED: DISCOVERED W9085 WHICH SPLIT L9076 (TOPSOIL) INTO L9084 W9085 AND L9086

DEFINITION/LIMITS: SECTION ALONG THE SOUTH OF W9085 REACHING EAST, SOUTH AND WEST Baulks.

MATRIX: DARK BROWN TOPSOIL WITH CHUNKS OF KURKAR, BROKEN CONCRETE, TESSERAE AND SMALL CHUNKS OF PLASTER. FLOOR OF POUNDED KURKAR

REASON FOR CLOSING: REACHED FLOOR 9086

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: FLOOR 9086 PROBABLY REPRESENTS

A LEVEL OF SUB-FLOORING FOR THE ORIGINAL FLOOR OF W9085

THIS LAYER OF KURKAR DEFINITELY REACHES THE WESTERN 2/3 OF THE SOUTH FACE OF W9085, BUT THE REMAINDER WAS SO POORLY PRESERVED IT WAS DIFFICULT TO BE SURE. THE LEVEL

OF THIS FLOOR CORRESPONDS TO THAT OF FLOOR 9091 NORTH OF W9085. IT IS 15 CMs LOWER THAN FLOOR 9084. IT SEEMS LIKELY THAT FLOORS 9086 AND 9091 ARE CONTEMPORARY.
