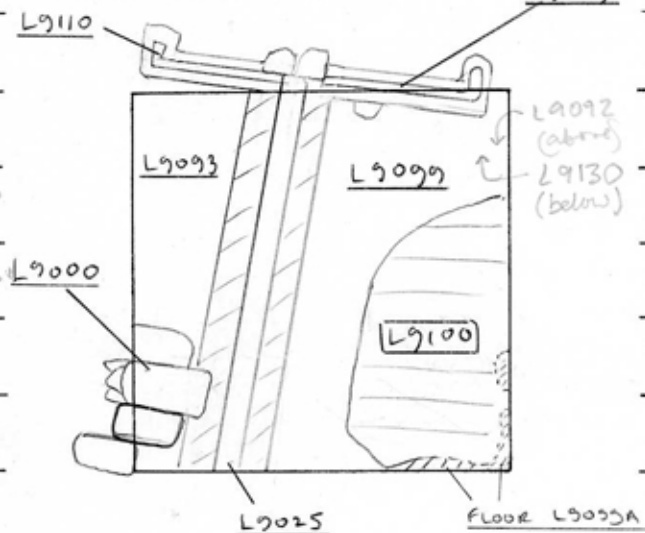

REASON FOR OPENING WE NOTED A CLEAR SOIL DISTINCTION, INDICATING THE PRESENCE OF A PIT IN THE S.E. OF THE SQUARE.

DEFINITION/LIMITS IT IS BOUNDED BY [L9093] ON THE NORTH AND WEST, AND BY THE EAST AND SOUTH BANKS. ABOVE IS [L9092] BELOW, [L9130].

MATRIX FINE, SANDY SOIL, WITH SHELLS AND A FEW LARGE FIELDSTONES, WITH A LOT MORE POTTERY THAN [L9092].

REASON FOR CLOSING THE MATERIAL OF THE PIT GAVE WAY TO A DARKER, BROWN CLAY - IDENTICAL TO L9099, BUT WITHOUT THE FRAGMENTS OF CEMENT AND PLASTER. COMBINED L9100 and L9099 into L9130.

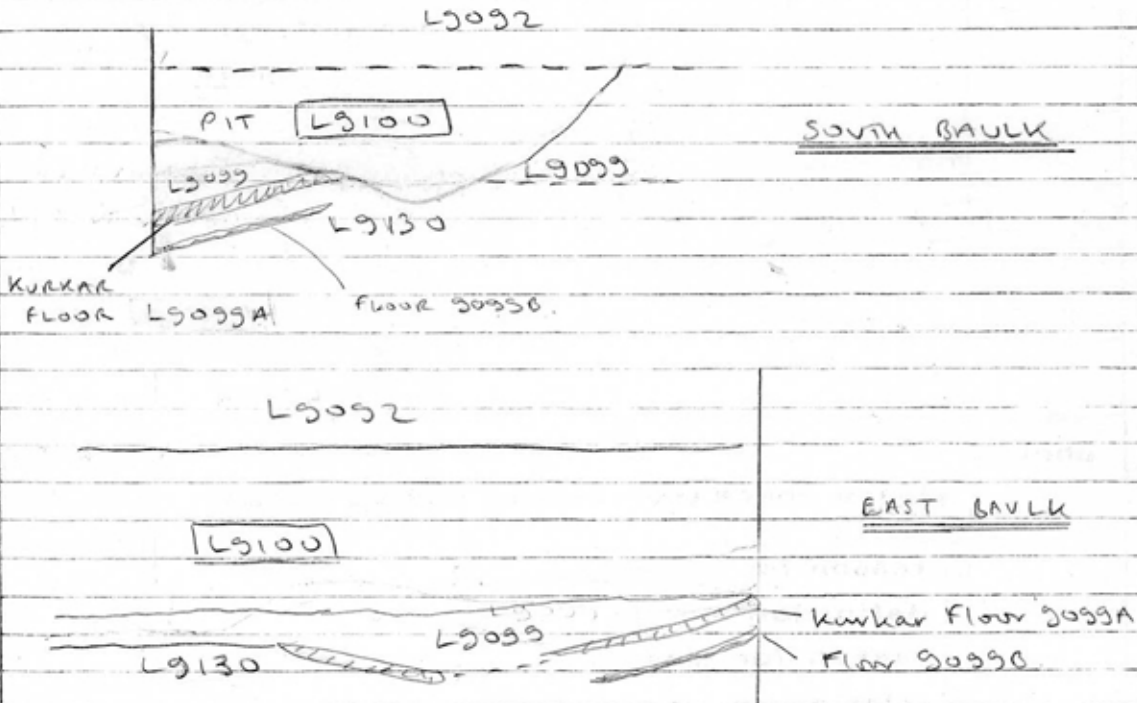
RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS PIT [L9100] PRESUMABLY CUT [L9093] AND THE KURAR FLOOR [L9099A] BELOW IT, - DESPITE THE FACT THAT THE LATEST POTTERY FROM THE PIT WAS E.T.S.A 03 WHILE [L9093] HAD PLENTY OF LATER POTTERY (02). (THIS COULD BE DUE MERELY TO CHANCE - ONLY DIAGNOSTIC SAMPLES WERE KEPT.) THE PIT WAS COVERED ABOVE BY [L9092], AND IT LAY ABOVE [L9093] AND FLOOR [L9099A] IN THE S.E. CORNER, AND ABOVE [L9130] AT ITS DEEPEST POINT. (SEE SECTION ON BACK). THIS PIT APPARENTLY DID NOT EXTEND INTO AI 31* WITH REGARD TO ITS RELATIVE DATE, WE CANNOT BE SURE IT IS

* ACTUALLY, IT WAS PROBABLY IDENTICAL WITH THE NORTHERN PART OF [L9093] - BUT WAS NOT DISTINGUISHED AS A SEPARATE

EARLIER THAN THE DRAIN [L9025]. IN THE SECTION OF THE EASTERN BALK, THE YELLOWISH BROWN MATERIAL OF THE PIT EXTENDS UP THROUGH THE DIAMETRICAL LEVEL OF [L9082], WHICH WAS OPENED FOR TECHNICAL REASONS ON THE DISCOVERY OF DRAIN [L9025], (ALTHOUGH HE DID NOT OPEN A SEPARATE LOCUS FOR THE PIT AT THAT TIME, FOR IT WAS NOT CLEARLY DISTINCT.) HENCE [L9025] CUTS [L9099], AND SO DOES THE PIT [L9100]; WE CAN'T TELL WHICH IS EARLIER
