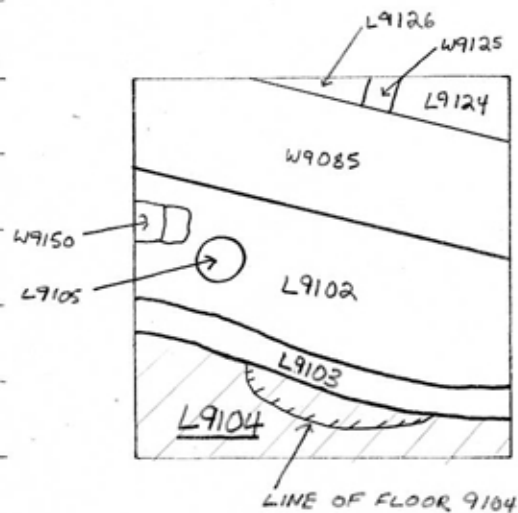

OPENED: OPENED UPON DISCOVERY OF L9103 (DRAIN) WHICH SPLIT L9094 (AREA SOUTH OF W9085) INTO L9102, L9105, L9103 AND L9104.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: AREA SOUTH OF L9103 WHICH REACHES EAST, WEST AND SOUTH Baulks.

MATRIX: SANDY GREY SOIL WITH MANY SHERDS, SOME SMALL CHUNKS OF PLASTER AND MUCH BONE. FLOOR SURFACE OF POUNDED KURHAR GRAVEL IMBEDDED WITH BONE AND SOME POTTERY SHERDS. SIMILAR TO MATERIAL IN AJ33 AT THE SAME LEVEL. SLIGHTLY DARKER AND HARDER THAN MATRIX OF 9102

REASON FOR CLOSING: REACHED FLOOR 9104

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: ALTHOUGH SECTIONS OF FLOOR 9104 DID APPEAR TO REACH DRAIN 9103 IT IS MORE LIKELY THAT THE DRAIN CUT THROUGH THE EARLIER FLOOR. THIS IS APPARENT IN THE SECTION. IT WOULD BE VERY ODD TO HAVE A DRAIN PROTRUDING 25 CMS ABOVE A FLOOR IN USE AT THE SAME TIME. EXPLANATION FOR THE INITIAL OBSERVATION CAN BE ACCOUNTED FOR BY THE FACT THAT SMALL STONES WERE PACKED INTO THE TRENCH CREATING THE ILLUSION THAT THE DRAIN AND FLOOR WERE CONNECTED. FLOOR 9104 IS CLEARLY THE SAME AS FLOOR 9010 IN AJ33. IT MAY ALSO REPRESENT THE SAME FLOOR AS L9008 IN AJ33. THE LEVELS ARE CLOSE ENOUGH TO CORRELATE.
