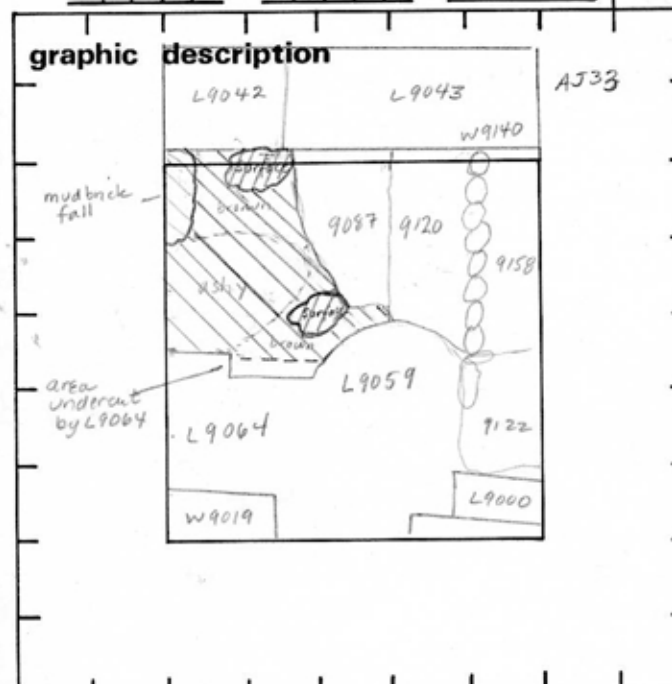

Summary:

Description: OPENING [L9128] was opened to excavate surface, [L9112] and material at the level of [L9112] surface but not sealed by floor.

DEF [L114] [L9128] is floor make up and material below floor, [L9112]. It is limited by L9087 in East, West baulk on west, [L9064] and [L9059] in south, [L9042] in North. Small patches of poorly preserved, compressed ash plaster surface noted in north - 85-185 cm from west baulk, and 75 cm N-S. Another was noted in the south next to [L9087], 2.35-2.65 cm from west baulk, approx 50 cm N-S.

Closed [L9128] was closed when an area of dark grey ash [L9142] was defined, with areas of light ash and soil to N and S.
