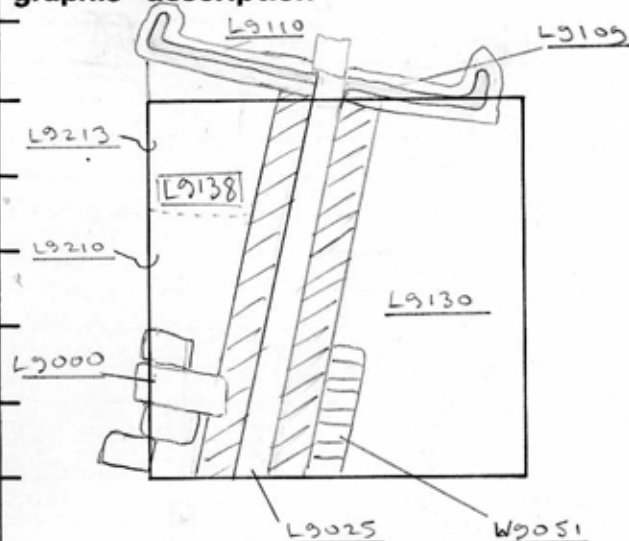

Description:

REASON FOR OPENING WE CAME DOWN UPON RUINED KURKAR FLOOR L9093 (DETECTABLE REALLY ONLY IN BAULK, AND ONLY IN OUR SQUARE - IT WAS NOT DETECTABLE EVEN IN THE CORRESPONDING BAULK SECTION OF AJ32.)

DEFINITION / LIMITS. EXTENDS FROM THE WEST BAULK TO THE WEST WALL OF DRAIN L9025 AND THE MATERIAL BELOW THE DRAIN WALL. EXTENDS FROM THE MATERIAL BELOW PAVEMENT L9000 TO THE MATERIAL BELOW THE SOUTH WALL OF DRAIN L9110.

MATRIX YELLOWISH SANDY SOIL ABOVE, MORE HARD-PACKED BELOW, WITH MANY FIST- AND DOUBLE-FIST-SIZED FIELD-STONES. IN THE SOUTH HALF THIS BECAME A SOLID MASS OF IRREGULARLY SIZED ROCKS - PERHAPS THE EXTENSION OF ~~PAVEMENT~~ L9050 FROM AJ32

(ILAN'S 'SUMP'). IN THE NORTH IT WAS MERELY FLOATING RUBBLE, WITH MASS OF MUD-BRICK MATERIAL.

REASON FOR CLOSING SOIL CHANGE IN NORTHERN PART TO UNBROKEN LAYER OF MUD-BRICK MATERIAL - CLEARLY DISTINCT FROM THE RUBBLE TO THE SOUTH.

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS L9138 LIES BELOW BADLY RUINED KURKAR FLOOR L9093, AND ABOVE THE MUD-BRICK MATERIAL OF L9213 AND THE IRREGULAR STONES OF L9210 (PARTIALLY PART OF L9090 FROM AJ32). IT IS PARTLY CUT BY THE WEST WALL OF DRAIN L9025
