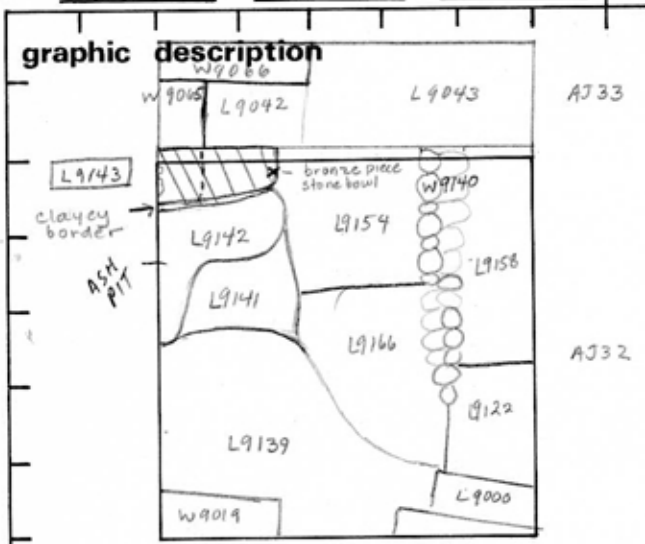

Summary:

Description: OPENED L9143 was opened when ash pit L9142 and two areas of lighter material L9141 + L9143 were distinguished below L9128. And to remove northern surface of L9128.

DEF/LIM L9143 is the soil north of L9142 and south of AJ33 L9042. It is limited by west bank. It is limited to the east by L9154.

CLOSING. Came down on northern extension of W9065

RELATIONS. L9143 is cut by L9142. A 5-10cm line of red hard clayey soil separates L9142 from L9143. L9143 touches the ^{overlies} red-brown soil of L9154, and at closing level becomes same soil as L9154. Its relationship to

L9042 of AJ33 is unknown. Maybe refuse associated with, usage of L9142

Matrix grey ashy soil becoming a brownish grey color. ^{similar to L9141} Harder red-brown clayey soil along southern edge. 5-10cm wide. At western bank isolated fragments of mudclay material and loose stones. Level with very top of W9065 soil becomes redbrown soil same as L9154
