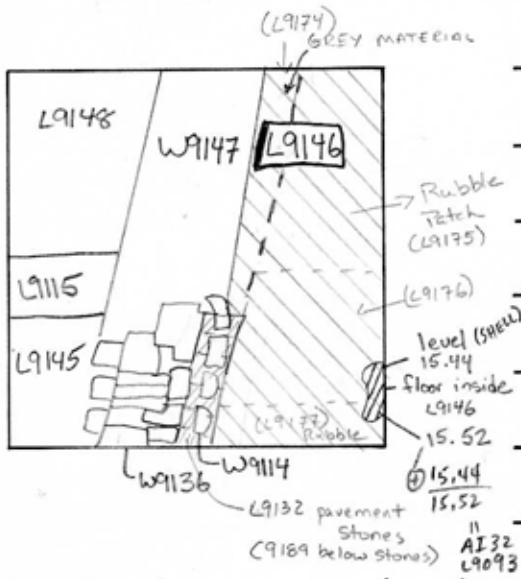

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**Summary:**

**Description:** OPENED: CAME DOWN ON [W9147] TO THE WEST OF [L9146] - TECHNICAL CHANGE.

DEFINITION / LIMITS: [L9146] BORDERED TO THE NORTH, SOUTH, AND EAST BY Baulks. TO THE NORTHWEST LIES [W9147] AND TO THE SOUTHWEST LIE THE PAVEMENT STONE FLOOR OF [L9132], AND BELOW THESE [L9177].

MATRIX: FOR THE MOST PART, LIGHT BROWN, SOFT EARTH WHICH CRUMBLES EASILY. ALONG EASTERN BAULK IS A PATCH OF DENSE SHELLS (MOSTLY IN BAULK) AND ALONG WALL [9147] RUNNING OUT TO AROUND 40cm. IS GREYER MATERIAL WHICH FADES IN AND OUT. WHEN FIRST NOTICED IT WAS GIVEN A NEW BASKET NUMBER THOUGH NOT A NEW LOCUS NUMBER.

REASON FOR CLOSING: GREY MATERIAL ALONG WALL WAS SEEN TO CONTINUE DOWN AND DENSE RUBBLE PATCHES WITHIN THE SOFT SOIL FOUND.

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: [L9146] LAY DIRECTLY BELOW [L9132] AND THE SOIL MATRIX BASICALLY THE SAME FOR BOTH, THOUGH [L9146] HAD A SHELL PATCH AND A GREY PATCH. BELOW [L9146] ARE TWO RUBBLE PATCHES (L9175) AND (L9177), AND [L9176] IS BASICALLY THE SAME MATERIAL AS [L9146]. THE GREY PATCH IS GIVEN A LOCUS NUMBER OF ITS OWN AT THE CLOSING OF [L9146] SINCE DIFFERENCE IN SOIL COLOR (GREYISH COMPARED TO LIGHT BROWN) CONTINUED. [L9146] ALSO LOOKS VERY SIMILAR TO SOIL FOUND

						UNDER PAVEMENT (FLOOR OF L9132) / L9189. A SMALL VERY PATCHY FLOOR (WHICH IS ALMOST COMPLETELY IN BALK) WAS FOUND IN THE SOUTH EAST CORNER. IT EXTENDED OUT OF THE BALK AT THE MOST AROUND 8cm. LEVELS AT HIGHEST AND LOWEST POINTS - 15.44 → 15.52. MORE OF FLOOR FOUND WHEN CLEANING BALK. LENGTH OF FLOOR ABOUT 20cm. THE OTHER PATCH FOUND COMPLETELY IN BALK WAS AROUND LENGTH 45cm. FLOOR NOTED AS BEING WITHIN [L9146] AND HAS NO LOCUS NUMBER CHANGE. FLOOR IS AT ABOUT THE SAME LEVEL AS THAT OF L9093 (level 15.54) IN A132; AND ALSO AT ABOUT THE SAME LEVEL AS THE TOP OF THE UPPER COURSE OF 9147 (at 15.57)
						NOTE ON GREY MATERIAL - IT BEGINS JUST ABOVE LEVEL OF [L9147] (SEEN IN BALK) AND MAY BE THE ORIGINAL SOIL NEXT TO [L9147] WHILE THE BROWN MATERIAL WITH RUBBLE FURTHER DOWN [L9135] MAY BE A ROBBER'S TRENCH. GREY MATERIAL EXTENDS ABOUT 60cm TO THE EAST OF [L9147], THEN BROWN MATERIAL BEGINS AND GOES TO BALK.

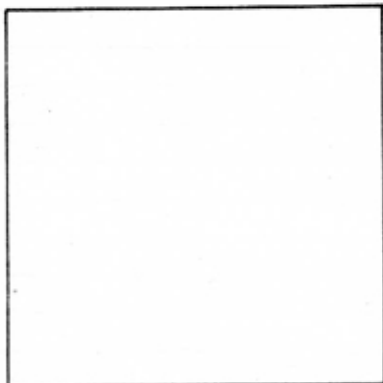
