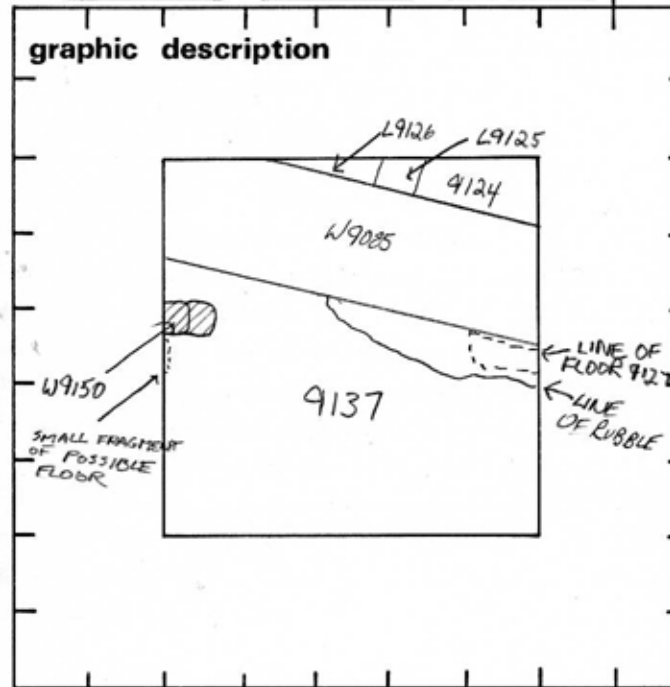

Description: [OPENED]: WHEN IT WAS DECIDED THAT TWO ASHLARS PROTRUDING FROM THE WEST BANK REPRESENTED A WALL DEFINITION/LIMITS WALL TWO ASHLARS LONG REACHING WEST BANK. SURROUNDED BY [9137] ON ALL SIDES WAS [20 CM LONG] IN TWO COURSES MATRIX ASHLAR WALL TWO COURSES DEEP OF STONES AVERAGING 40X40X25 CMS.

REASON FOR CLOSING: REMOVED WALL

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS [L9137] REACHES [WALL 9150] UNTIL 1556 WHEN [W9150] FLOAB UPON [9137]. NO FLOORS WERE FOUND EXCEPT FOR A 20 CM LONG FRAGMENT AT 15.80 WHICH MAY BE REMAINS OF A FLOOR WHICH ORIGINALLY REACHED [W9150]. RUBBLE WAS

FOUND ON THE SOUTH OF [W9085] WHICH MAY HAVE FILLED A ROBBER TRENCH, BUT NO DISCERNABLE ROBBER TRENCH LINE WAS FOUND. THE ONLY OTHER POSSIBLE CANDIDATE FOR A FLOOR RELATED TO [9150] IS FLOOR [9127] WHICH WAS ONLY PRESERVED IN A SMALL SECTION SOUTH OF [9085]. THE LEVEL (1585-1579) MAKES THIS A REASONABLE POSSIBILITY. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THIS FLOOR WAS COVERED BY THE SAME RUBBLE THAT DEFINES THE POSSIBLE ROBBER TRENCH.
