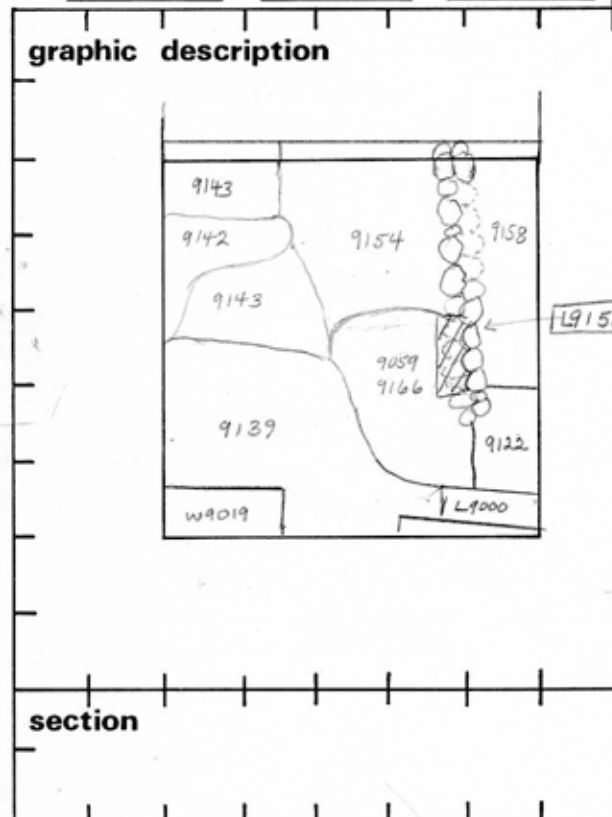

IT is equivalent to the edge of pit L9059, south of L9154. The entire locus extends approx. 60 cm N-S.

Relations: <input type="checkbox"/> L9153 comes down on the lower course of the western row of stones of L9140 and reaches the western face of the upper course of the eastern row. The soil of <input type="checkbox"/> L9153 reaches the soil of <input type="checkbox"/> L9154 and may cut it as part of ^{Persian} pit L9059, and L9166 below it.
