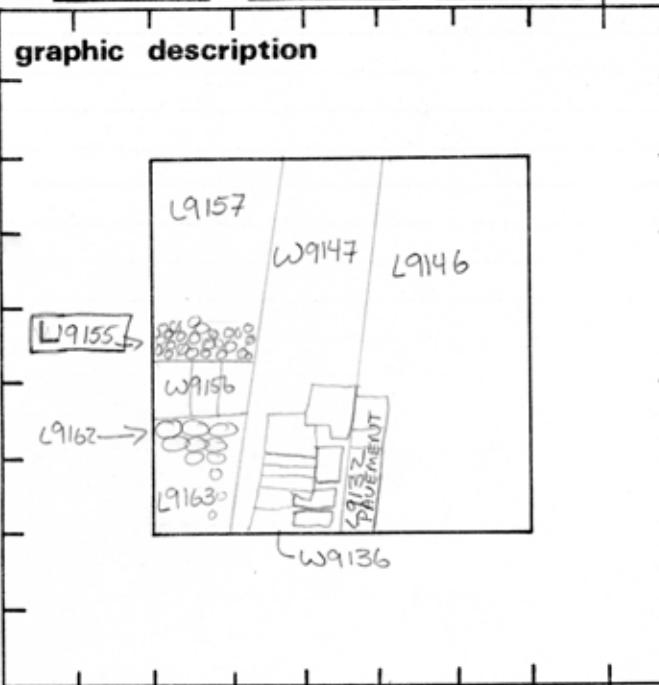

**Description:** OPENED: CAME DOWN ON RUBBLE FILL OF A ROBBER TRENCH.

**DEFINITION / LIMITS:** TO THE WEST [W9155] GOES INTO WESTERN BAWLK, TO THE EAST [W9155] BORDERS [W9147] TO THE NORTH LIES [L9157] AND TO THE SOUTH IS LOCUS [L9115] AND BELOW [L9115] / [W9136].

**MATRIX:** UNCUT RUBBLE STONES THE SIZE OF A LARGE FIST AND LARGER.

**REASON FOR CLOSING:** TOOK OUT RUBBLE AND REACHED TWO BLOCKS AT THE BOTTOM [W9200].

**RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS:** [L9155] CONSISTS OF RUBBLE STONES THROWN IN WITH REDDISH CLAY SOIL. AT FIRST [L9155] LOOKED LIKE A POSSIBLE WALL, BUT NOW BELIEVED TO BE A ROBBER'S TRENCH SINCE ALTHOUGH THE NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN BORDERS ARE STRAIGHT, THE RUBBLE ITSELF IS LAID AT RANDOM AND AT THE BOTTOM OF

THE RUBBLE, TWO CUT BLOCKS [W9200] WERE FOUND [L9155] IS CUT BY [W9147] TO THE EAST. TO THE SOUTH [L9155] IS CUT BY [L9115] (A LATER ROBBER'S TRENCH) UNTIL [L9115] ENDS ON TOP OF [W9156]. THEN TO THE SOUTH [W9155] LOOKS AS IF IT IS CUT BY [W9156] WHICH IS A SINGLE COURSE OF 3 FLAT BLOCKS. [W9155] RESTS DIRECTLY ON [L9168] AND [L9200]. TO THE NORTH [L9155] CUTS [L9148] AND [L9157].
