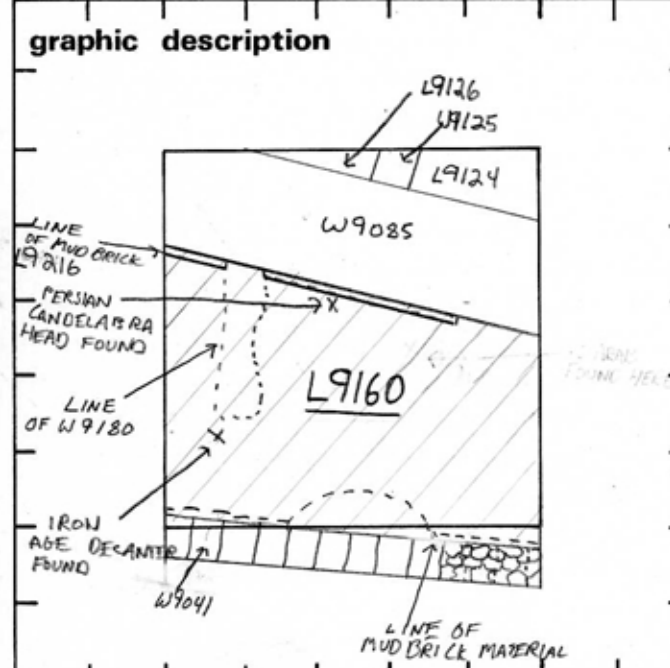

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: [L9160] REACHES THIN LINE OF MUD BRICK MATERIAL ON THE NORTH FACE OF [W9041], ROUGH BLOCK AND RUBBLE WALL UNDER [W9085] FLOATS ABOVE

A CM LAYER OF [L9160] THEN [L9160] REACHES SOUTH FACE OF [L9216] (MUD BRICK WALL FACE) (SEE SECTION)
