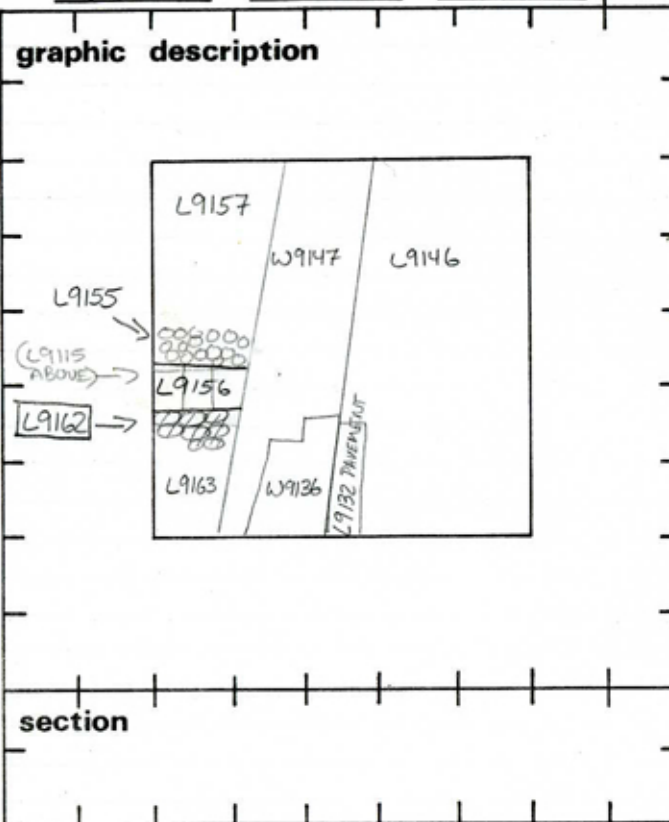

Description: OPENED: CAME DOWN UPON A TWO COURSE DEEP, THREE COURSE WIDE LINE OF RUBBLE.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: [L9162] ENDS (2cm) JUST BEFORE REACHING THE WESTERN BAWLK. ONE ROCK GOES INTO WESTERN BAWLK. IT ALSO ENDED BEFORE REACHING [W9136] OR [W9147] TO THE WEST. TO THE SOUTH [L9163] IS CUT BY [L9162] AND TO THE NORTH IT BORDERS WITH [L9115] AND [L9156] BELOW.

MATRIX: RUBBLE STONES LAID ON TOP OF EACH OTHER (TWO COURSES) AND THREE COURSES WIDE.

REASON FOR CLOSING: TOOK OUT RUBBLE.

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: [L9162] LAY DIRECTLY ABOVE [L9196] AND DIRECTLY BELOW [L9145]. WHEN FIRST FOUND IT WAS THOUGHT TO BE A WALL FOUNDATION. AFTER BEING TAKEN DOWN IT SEEMS MORE LIKELY TO BE RUBBLE. [L9162] CUTS ^{or possibly reaches} [L9163]. IT

DOESN'T QUITE REACH [W9136] OR [W9147] SO ASSOCIATION UNCLEAR (IF THERE IS ANY AT ALL). [L9162] COMES to a level just above (5cm) [L9156] TO THE NORTH. IT COULD POSSIBLY BE A ROBBER'S TRENCH cut by [L9115] BUT THE DIRT BETWEEN THE RUBBLE STONES AND THAT OF [L9163] AND [L9145] TO THE SOUTH AND ABOVE IT LOOK EXACTLY THE SAME. TO THE NORTH IT
