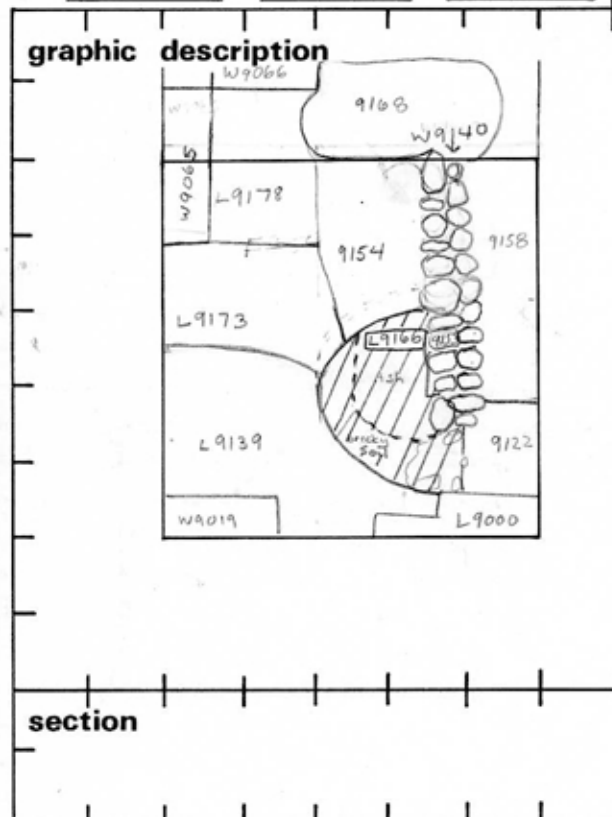

It is bounded on the north by L9154, on the west by L9173 on the south by pit L9139 on the east by W9140, and L9122			
CLOSED L9166 was closed when ashy pit L9185 was distinguished cutting into a hard mudbrickly material on the W, + South, L9190			
RELATIONS L9166 reaches L9154. It is cut on the south + west by L9139. It reaches wall W9140. It reaches the soil of L9122.

Matrix? Mixed matrix of soft grey ash, mudbrickly material and soil similar to L9122. and stones. The soft grey ash is identical to the soil of L9153 which covered the second course of the western row of W9140. It may be same as L9059, Persian pit which was above.

Note: Bottom level of L9166 virtually the same as L9059; this means that L9166 was winter wash and debris.
