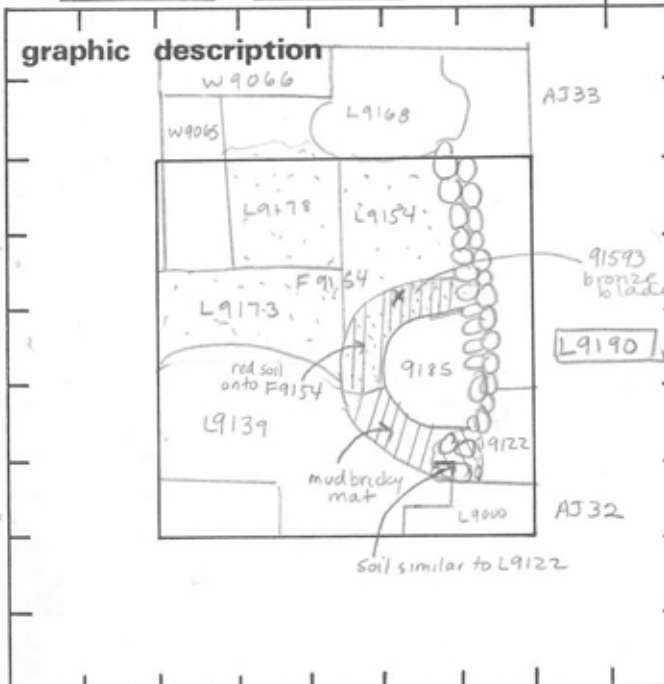

**Summary:**

**Description:**  OPENED  L9190 was opened when an ash pit  L9185 was noted below  L9166. The semicircle around the pit is  L9190.

DEFINITION  L9190 is a semi-circle of soils around the western part of  L9185.  L9190 is limited on the west by  L9139 and  L9173. It is limited on the north by  L9154, 20cm of L9154 were annexed to  L9190 to contain pit  L9185. It is bounded on the east by  L9185 and  W9140 and  L9122.

CLOSED Came down on Floor  L9154 in northern part of square Southern part becomes  L9203.

L9173 and  L9154. It reaches soil of  L9122 but a line of rubble possibly from  W9140 intervenes. The soil of  L9190 was similar to  L9122 for 25cm extending west from  L9122. Mudbricky material and rubble extending west from there, this may have been a wall cut by  L9139 and  L9122 and  L9185. Northern part of  L9190 came down on  F9154 which was cut by  L9185, and reached  W9140. The northern part was identical to  L9154 and  L9173.
