Summary:

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: Excavation of L9170 to the level of L9111 going NE indicated robber trench, investigation of which L9197 was designated.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: Locus L9197 runs NE towards the corner of the square made by NE baulks, from the point at which drain channel L9111 was found collapsed and discontinued along an anticipated NE course. It is bordered by the E baulk and lies E. beneath the bottom level of L9170.

REASON FOR CLOSING: End of excavation season level attained (with sufficient exposure of the remains / discontinuity of drains L9111 verifying a robber trench, not closed)

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: Locus 9197 is an excavated extension of the anticipated course of drain channel L9111 (into the N and E baulks, below the level of L9170) lying N.

MATRIX: Material in L9197 is mostly a fine texture dark brown earth (unlike any soil previously encountered in AI34), which is darker than the apparent soil color observed in the section of L9111 at the S limit of L9197, but of similar texture.

If L9197 is a Robber Trench it cuts L9170 and Robbed at Drain L9111.
