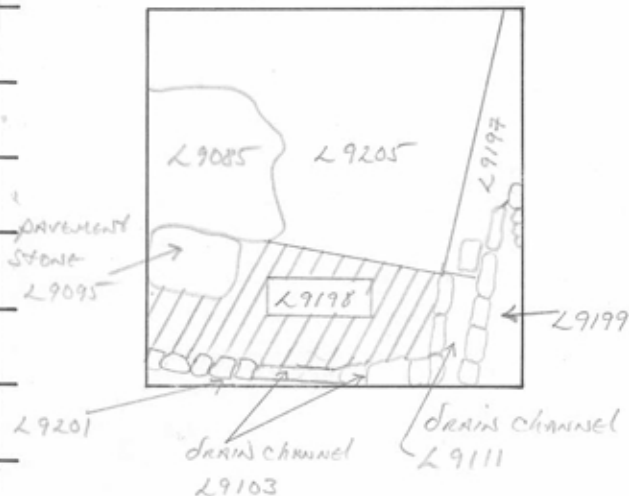

Summary:

Description: Reason for opening: Locus 9198 was opened in order to expose sufficiently upper surface of drain channel (L9103) for end of season excavation + photos.

Definition / limits: L9198 is the south-eastern section of AJ34 running S of Locus 9205, bounded E. by drain channel L9111, on the S by drain channel L9103, on the W by a bank (its upper level = the level of L9103 capstones-W) and NW by paving stone L9095 and a portion of L9085.

Reason for closing: end of excavation season level is attained with sufficient exposure of the upper portions of channel stones in drain L9103. Not Closed

Relation to other elements: L9198 is cut by drain L9103 in its southern reach, and apparently cut by drain channel L9111 at its eastern reach. It reaches L9205 at, and was overlain by paving stone (surface?) L9095, NW. A section of L9198 creates a bank between L9095 and L9103 capstones.

Matrix: Material in locus 9198 is a yellow brown soil packed hard with small stones and Kustai throughout. The material is the same as that in L9094 and L9102 in AJ34 to the W.
