Description: OPENED: CAME DOWN UPON TWO BLOCKS joining W9147 AT THE BOTTOM OF ROBBER'S TRENCH W9155.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: BELOW RUBBLE OF L9155 AND ABOVE L9188. ON EASTERN SIDE W9200 joins W9147. ON NORTH, WEST, AND SOUTHERN SIDES IS L9188.

MATRIX: TWO LARGE LIMESTONE BLOCKS - ONE 44 BY 16 CM, THE OTHER 56 CM LONG, BUT UNKNOWN HOW WIDE SINCE IT IS REUSED AND HAS BECOME PART OF THE LOWEST (FOURTH) COURSE OF W9147.

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF SEASON

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: L9200 WAS FOUND AT THE BOTTOM OF A ROBBER'S TRENCH L9155 WHICH WAS FILLED IN WITH RUBBLE ROCKS. IT CUTS L9188 WHICH LIES DIRECTLY BENEATH W9200, AND ALSO <sup>which</sup> LIES TO THE NORTH, WEST, AND SOUTH OF W9200. W9200 IS JOINED TO W9147 AND ONE OF ITS BLOCKS IS REUSED AS PART OF W9147. W9147 WAS LAID OVER THE REMAINS OF THE EARLIER W9200.
