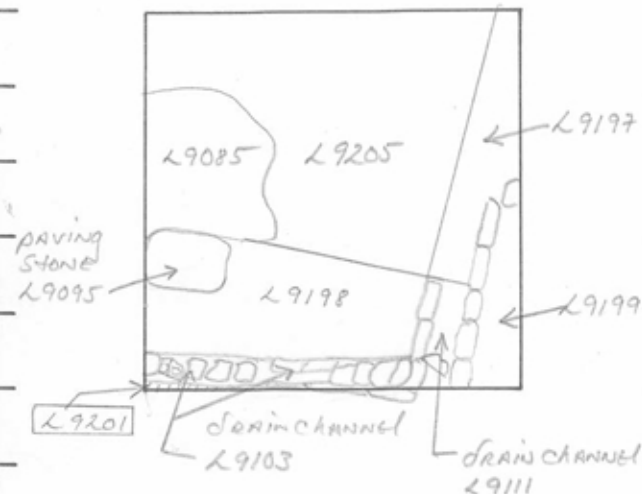

Summary:

Description: Reason for opening: L9201 was opened with the purpose of exposing as much of the upper portion of the drain channel (L9103) as possible, without intruding upon floor level (L9077 (= AI33) + L9104 (= AI34), and to achieve end of season general square level. Definition / limits: L9201 is a small locus on the drain outer scarp edge SW of AI34, bordered and cut off SW → SE by drain channel L9103.

Reason for closing: L9201 was closed after sufficient exposure of drain channel (L9103), right upon floor, L9077 / L9104, with an end of excavation season level. Not closed.

Relation to other elements: L9201 was cut by drain channel L9103, and previously lay under intersection of N and S baulk, with a thin portion E of S baulk and N of S baulk underlying L9169 up to drain L9103.

Material: Material from L9201 consisted of hard packed yellowish earth with kurbur and small stones in admixture, somewhat similar to material above it contained in L9169.
