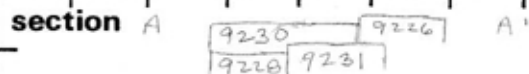
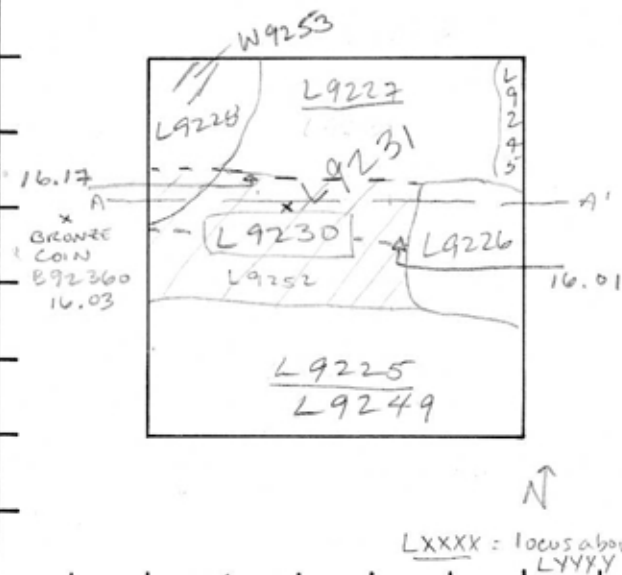

MATRIX: LOOSE YELLOW-GREY SOIL WITH SMALL AND LARGE ROCKS, FEW BONES, POTTERY, TESSERAE, CHUNKS OF CONCRETE. CHANGE IN SOIL COLOR (DARK BROWN) IN NORTHERN HALF OF LOCUS, FILL APPEARS UNCHANGED POTTERY FROM N AND S HALVES OF SQUARE SEPARATED B92342-S B92351-N.

CLOSED: (L9230) COMES DOWN UPON LOOSE GREY-BROWN SOIL (L9252) IN ITS SOUTHERN HALF, CUTTING INTO HARD RED SOIL OF (L9249) TO THE SOUTH; IN ITS NORTHERN HALF (L9230) COMES DOWN UPON CONTINUATION OF (L9231) AND (L9228).
