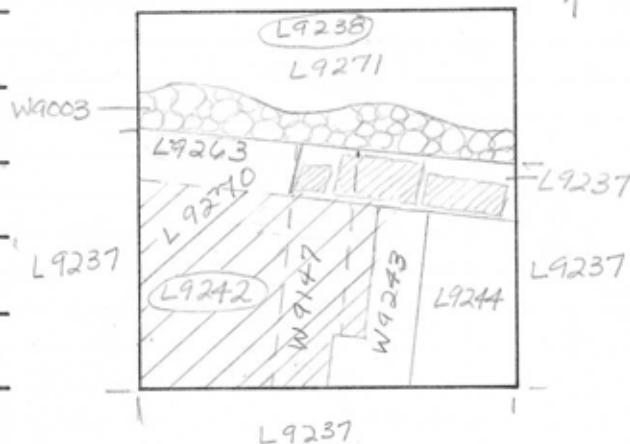

Summary:

Description:

Opened: Excavation revealed the presence of [W9243], which split the above locus [9237] into [L9242], [W9243], & [L9244].

Matrix: Medium brown soil containing clumps of kurkar, & few fragments of tesserae & roofing tiles. →*

Definition/Limits: [L9242] is bounded to the S & W by the baulks. To the N, [L9242] is bound by [L9263], which consisted of material underlying a possible kurkar sub-floor. To the E, [L9242] is bounded by the header wall [9243].

Reason for Closing: Excavation revealed the presence of [W9147], which cut [L9242].

At this level, the soils of [L9242] & [L9263] were determined to be identical & were combined to form [L9270].

Relation to Other Elements: The header wall [9243] cuts loci [9242] & [L9244]. [L9242] reaches [L9263]. [L9242] is cut by the paving stones of Floor [9237]. Excavation revealed the presence of [W9147] beneath [L9242]. The locus cut by [W9147], & lying beneath [L9242] is [L9270].
