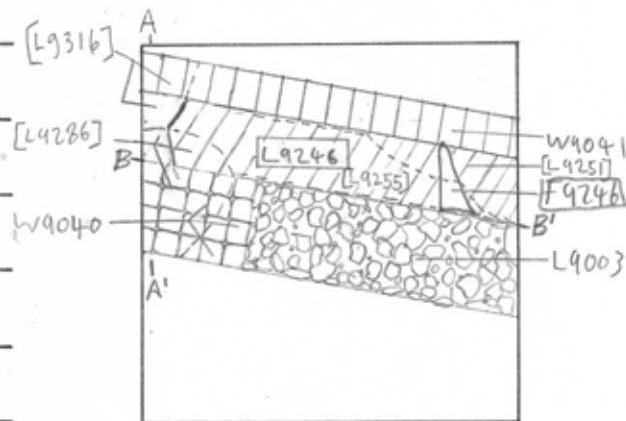

Summary:

Description:

opened: when [W9015] was removed and material beneath was exposed.

definition/limits: [L9316], [L9286] TO THE WEST, THE EASTERN LIMIT OF AJ33, wall [9041] to the North and [W9040] and [L9003] to the South.

matrix: loose, sandy yellow soil with few sherds, and white ^{chunky} floor.

reason for closing: Loose, sandy soil removed and surface of [L9251], [L9255], [L9286], and [F9246] discovered. [L9251], [L9286] are Persian pits, [L9255] is mudbrick material with fieldstones in it, [F9246] is a small, thin floor fragment approx. 9x4cm of white chunky material.

relation to other elements: [L9246] reaches the mudbrick material / fieldstone face of W9041. It was covered by [W9015] and

covers [L9251], [L9255], [L9246] reaches [L9316] which also then served as bedding for [W9015],

and possibly reaches [W9041]. The floor is very fragmentary at [W9041] and the relation difficult to determine. [L9246] is probably later than [W9041] it is higher and has fewer early sherds. Relationship of [L9246] (cuts or reaches?) and [W9003], [L9246] IS PROBABLY LATER THAN [W9041]. JUDGING FROM ITS ASSOCIATION AS BEDDING FOR [W9015] WHICH IS ALMOST CERTAINLY LATER THAN [W9041], [L9246] COVERS THE GREATER PORTION OF [L9286], AND CUTS IT BUT LEAVES PART OF [L9286] TO COME UP AND TOUCH THE BOTTOM OF [W9015].
