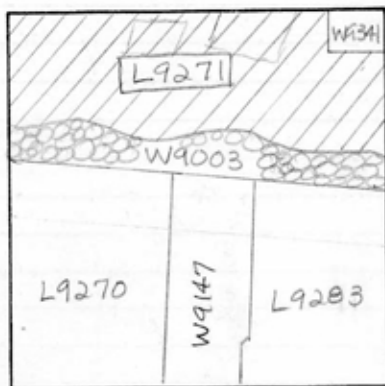

Summary:

Description: Reason for Opening: Excavation revealed wall [9341] in NE corner of AK33.

Definition/Limits: [L9271] is bounded to the S by [W9003], & to the N, E, & W by the banks.

Reason for Closing: Not closed - End of Season

Relation to Other Elements: [L9271] is cut to the S by [W9003], & in the NE corner of Square AK33, by [W9341]. [L9238] is the locus directly above [L9271].

Matrix: Light brown soil, very fine & loose, & containing numerous rocks, many of which are likely tumble from [W9003]. Matrix of [L9336], at similar level in Square AK34, differs from that of [L9271] in that [L9336] consists of medium

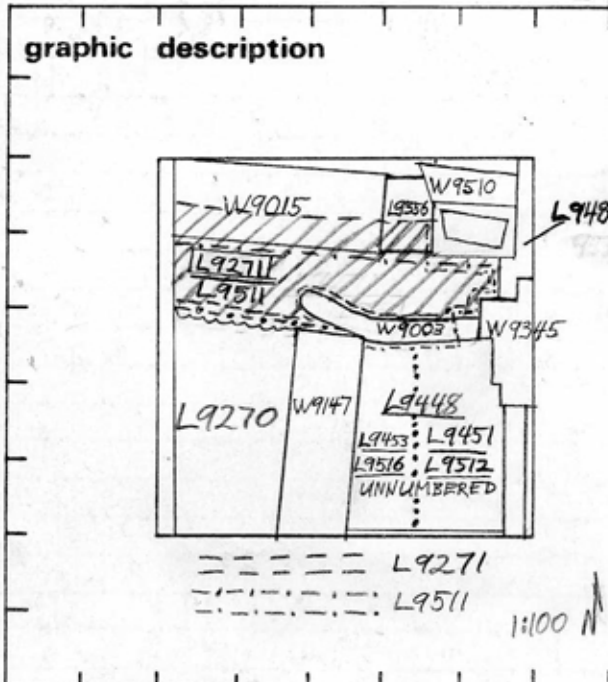
brown soil, densely packed, although also containing numerous rocks.
