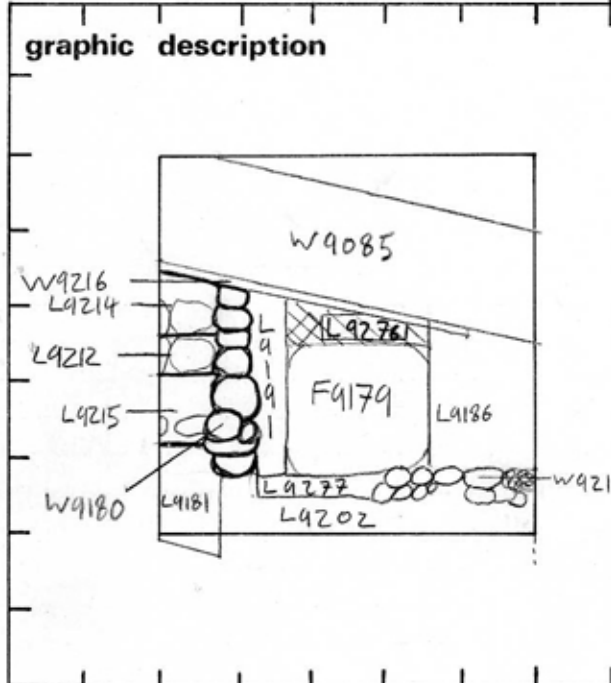

Summary: _____

Description: Opened: when area North of [F9179] was deemed separate from [L9179] and probable wall tumble.

Matrix: light brown, deteriorated mudbrick material w/ fist sized fieldstones in it and one large block 60cm X 20cm X 30cm.

Reason for Closing: not closed, end of '88 season.

Definition/Limits: [L9276] is defined by [W9216] to the North, by [L9186] to the East, [F9179] to the South, and by [L9191] to the West.

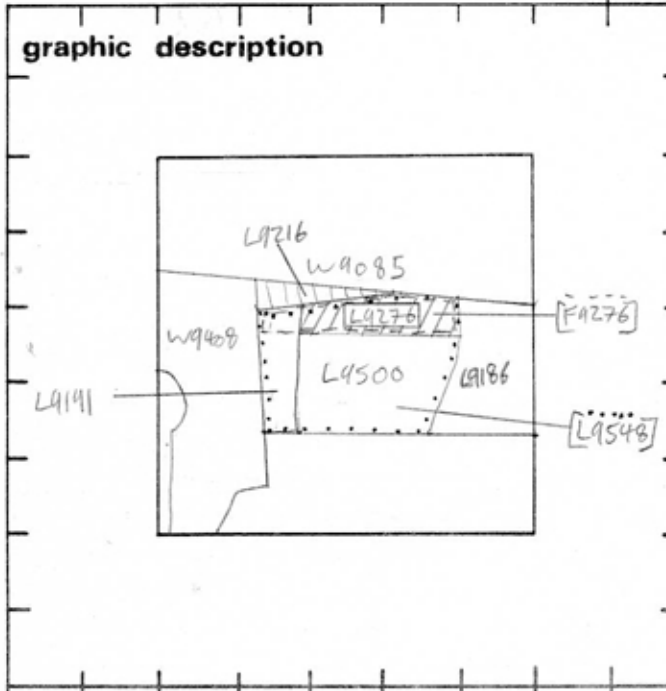
Relationship to Other Elements: [L9276] reaches [L9191] and [W9216]. [F9179] reaches [L9276]. [L9186] cuts [L9276]. [L9179] covers [L9276]. [L9276] could be its

own feature or could be tumble from [W9216]. This relationship, however, is hazy because of the poor state of preservation of [L9276]

Description: Opened: See Card #1

Matrix: see Card #1

Definition/Limits: see Card #1

Reason for closing: collapsed w/ L9191 and L9500 below F9179 when all 3 were determined to be of the same matrix.

Relationship to Other Elements: See Card #1

in addition: L9276 reaches L9500 and covers L9548. F9276 reaches W9216 and W9408; it also seals the northern portion of L9548. F9276 is cut by L9186. F9276 appears to be the first floor associated w/ W9408 + W9216. It is floor I of this room. This is why Floor II + III in L9548, the remaining portion of the room defined by walls W9408 and W9216, are called Floors II + III; the material below

F9276 was not opened as a separate "sealed" deposit, but collapsed with F9191 and L9500 because it was recognized that these were all one deposit.
