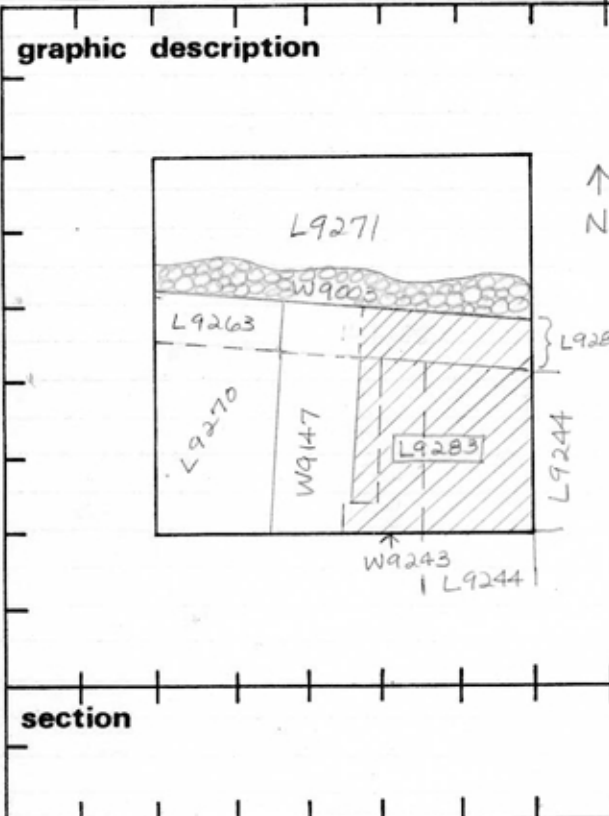

Summary:

Description: Reason for Opening: Removal of Header wall [9243] & of material of [L9285] (below paving stones of [L9237]) revealed soil identical to that of [L9244]; therefore these loci were combined to form [L9283].

Definition / Limits: [L9283] is bounded on the N by [W9003], to the W by [W9147], and to the E & S by the baulks.

Reason for closing: Not closed: End of Season

Relation to Other Elements: [L9283] is cut by [W9003] and by [W9147]. The loci lying above were [L9244], [L9285], and [W9243].

Matrix: [L9283] consists of light brown soil, densely packed, & containing numerous chunks of rock. [L9270] consists of light brown sandy soil, very fine & loose, & containing much pottery.

[L9271] consists of light brown soil, very fine & loose, & containing numerous rocks, many of which are likely tumble from [W9003]. The matrices at similar levels in AK32 were also light brown like that of [L9283], but were looser, sandier, & contained little pottery fragments.
