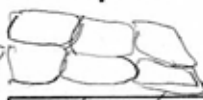

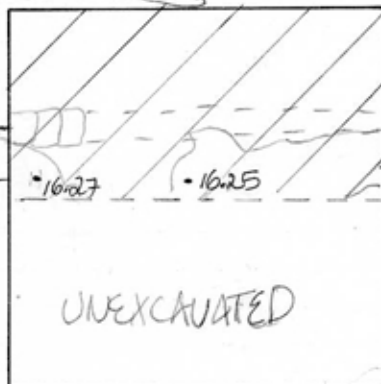

REASON FOR OPENING: SOIL CHANGE
 DEFINITION AND LIMITS: EXTENDS FROM AM 35 TO THE SOUTHERN
 BOUNDARY OF EXCAVATIONS IN THIS SQUARE ca. 2.5M
 MATRIX: LIGHT SANDY SOIL CONTAINING MUCH PLASTER AND RUBBLE,
 SOME SCATTERED KURKAR, MANY BONE FRAGMENTS DOWN TO PLASTER FLOOR.
 REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON FLOOR 9289 ALONG
 SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF EXCAVATIONS (PLASTER), AND ON L9103
 RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: OVERLAYS FLOOR 9289 AND
 L9103. F9289 IS HIGHER THAN L9103 AND COULD HAVE
 COVERED L9103 AT SOME TIME. F9250/W9273 IN
 THE NW CORNER OF SQUARE AM 35 FLOATS ABOVE
 THE CLOSING ELEVATION OF L9289. L9289 OPENED
 JUST BELOW THE ELEVATION OF W9273/F9250.
 W9273/F9250 DOES NOT REACH SQUARE AM 34.

F9289 IS NOT A SUBFLOOR FOR
 F9250/W9273 IN SQUARE AM 35 IT
 IS MUCH LOWER IN ELEVATION AND
 DOES NOT REACH THAT SIDE OF THE
 SQUARE.
