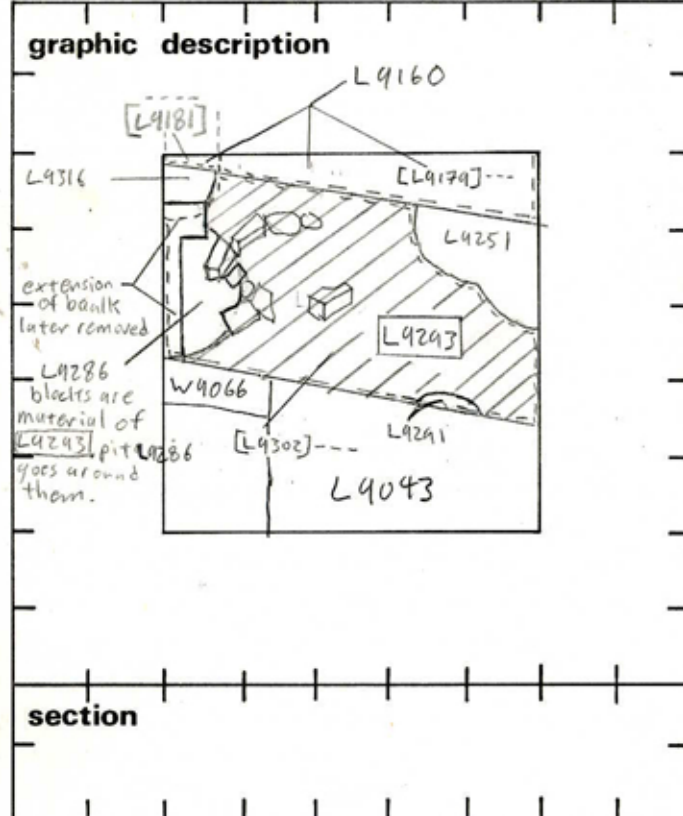

Summary:

Description: OPENED: When L9255 was excavated to the level of the material beneath W9041 and collapsed with it, L9003 and the material beneath W9040.

Definition/Limits: Bounded by L9286 and L9316 to the west, L9160 to the north, L9251 and the eastern limit of A533 to the east, and L9291, L9043, to the South.

Matrix: Mudbrick material with some small plaster bits and sherds in it, with fallen blocks and fieldstones in the western half of the square.

Reason for Closing: Closed when L9286 (pit) was defined and mudbrick material beneath was collapsed with L9293 to form L9302.

Relation to other elements: L9293 is cut by L9286, L9316, L9251 and L9291. L9293 is covered by W9041, L9255, W9040, and L9003. L9293 covers L9302. L9293 is also cut by L9160 and L9179 (excavated '87 season) to the North, and by L9043 (excavated '86 season) to the South. L9293 may reach or be cut by W9066, but this wall was excavated in '86 and badly weathered.
