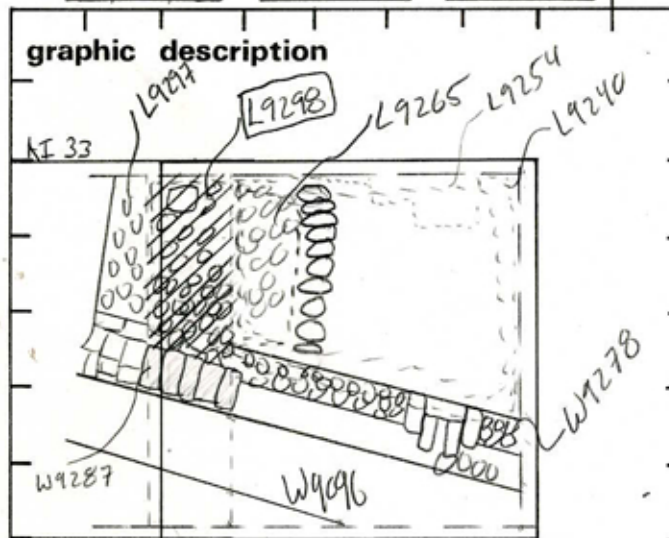

MATRIX: DARK HARD PACKED SOIL AND RUBBLE

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF SEASON, NOT CLOSED

RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: RUBBLE REACHES (?) WALL

W9278 - COVERED BY L9240. REACHES L9254

AND L9265. THIS LOCUS CONSISTED MAINLY OF

BAULK DIRT CLEARED FROM THE RUBBLE.

THE RUBBLE IS NOT A WALL. RUBBLE BEGINS BELOW 15.96, THE

BOTTOM COURSE OF W9287. L9297 AND L9265 BOTH

CONTAIN THE SAME RUBBLE AS L9298 AND REACH L9298.

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## Summary

Opened: See 1988 card for AH33.

Limits (N) Unexcavated balk in A134

(S) W9278

(E) L9637, L9646 and W9702

(W) W9684 and L9643

Closed: No rubble was removed, W9675 was defined. The portion of locus south of this was changed to L9674

Matrix: Several "double-head" size boulders, many head-size and smaller cobbles, winter wash soil above mud-brick debris. - See also 1988 season card for AH33

Relations: For all previous relations see 1988 card for AH33.

L9298 reaches W9684; an early Iron Age wall.

L9298 is cut by W9278, a Persian pier and rubble wall.

L9298 is probably a continuation of rubble fall L9643.

L9298 is almost certainly fall from W9675 (which it covers)

and also probably another Iron Age wall of which L9643 is

also fall. L9298 covers L9674, L9637 and L9646 both

reach L9298 - these are both winter wash loci. L9298

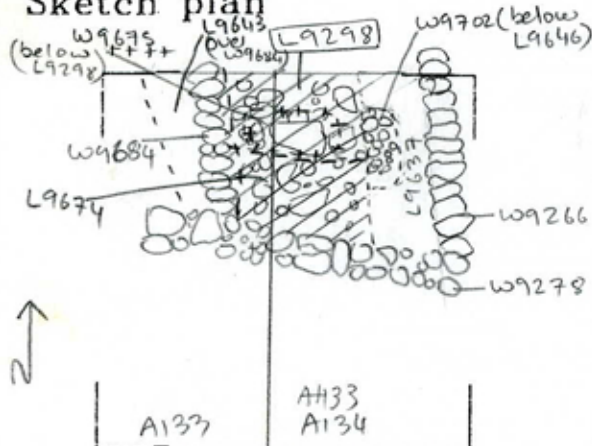
reaches the possible wall W9702 and is a continuation of the rubble at the base of W9702.

Additional Observations/Value: Rubble fall from W9675. Likely disturbed.
