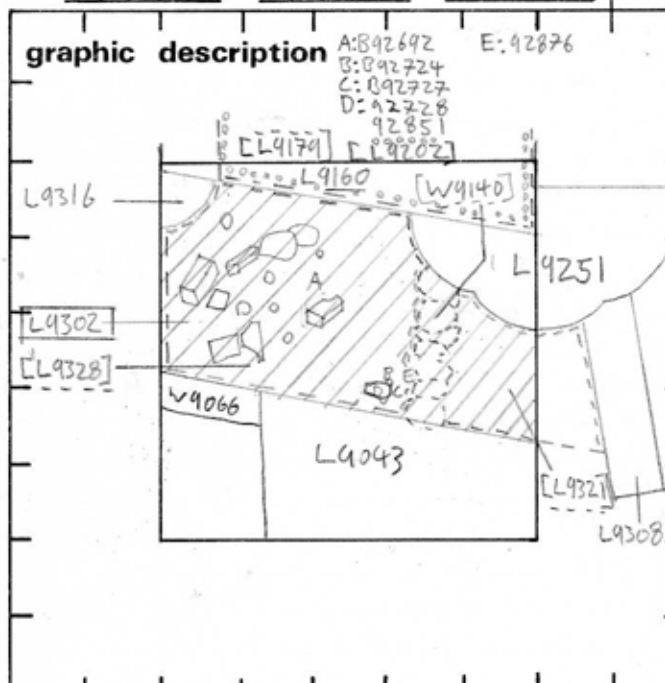

Description: opened: when L9293 was collapsed with material beneath L9286.

Definition/Limits: L9302 is bounded to the West by the Western bank and L9316, to the North by L9160 and L9251, to the East by the Eastern limit of SQ AJ33, and to the South by L9043 and W9066 (?)

Matrix: mudbrick material with chulky material in small amounts. Rough hewn and undressed blocks and fieldstones are prevalent in the western portion of the square.
