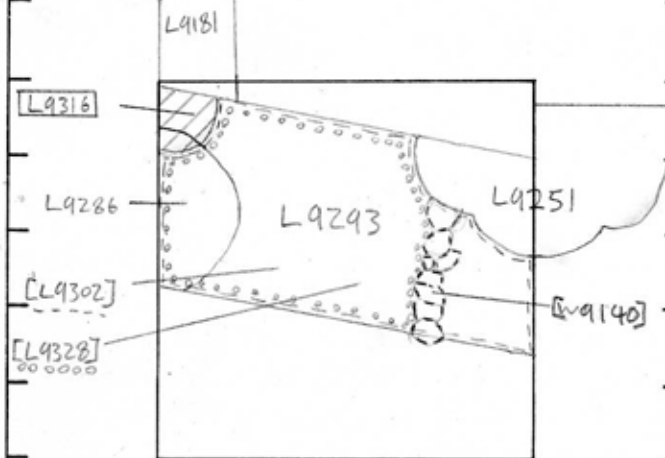

Description:

Opened: when material beneath W9041 was noticed to include a small ashy area by the West Baulk

Definition/Limits:

Bounded by the West Baulk, L9293 to the South and East, and by L9181 to the North.

Matrix:

light grey fill

Reason For Closing:

not closed, end of '88 season.

Reason For Closing:

Pit L9316 is cut by pit L9286 which can be determined from the baulk profile. L9316 cuts L9293, L9302, and L9328. L9316 is also cut/covered by W9015 and W9041. L9181 is either a continuation of L9316 or cuts

L9316. The opening level of this locus is high because a pedestal supporting a tent post concealed the true extent of locus, which could be discerned in the baulk. This pedestal was not removed until the end of the '88 season.

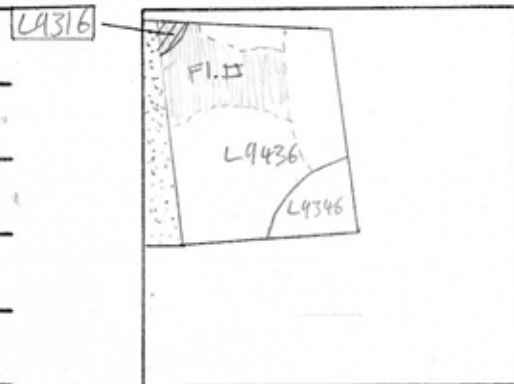
