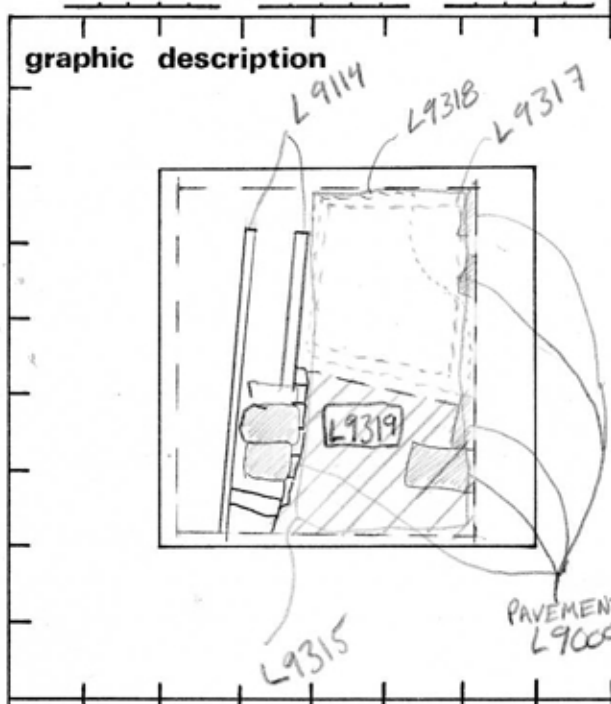

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: [L9315] CAME DOWN ON A SOIL CHANGE AND BECAME [L9317] A SHEIC AND KURAR FILLED LOCUS ON THE NORTHERN SIDE, AND [L9319] A LIGHT BROWN LOCUS WITH LITTLE SHELL MATERIAL ON THE SOUTH.

DEFINITION/LIMITS: [L9319] IS BELOW [L9315] AND IS BOUNDED BY THE EAST AND SOUTH BAULKS [L9114] ON THE WEST AND [L9317] AND [L9318] ON THE NORTH.
 MATRIX: BROWN SANDY SOIL CONTAINING MUCH POTTERY AND SOME ROOF TILES, NO TESSERAE WERE FOUND. MUCH STONE RUBBLE.

REASON FOR CLOSING: NOT CLOSED END OF SEASON
 RELATION TO OTHER ELEMENTS: REACHES EAST WALL OF [L9114] CUTS [L9317] AND [L9318] TO NORTH.
