Description: Reason for Opening: Excavation in Square AK34 revealed presence of W9340

Definition/Limits: L9336 is bounded to the N by drain L9103, to the E by W9243, & to the W by the W bank. To the S, L9336 is bounded by the S bank on the W side, & by W9340 on the E side of the locus.

Reason for Closing: Not Closed - End of Season. Closed due to SOIL CHANGE BEGINNING OF 1979 SEASON. 6 ORANGE, W9085

Relation to Other Elements: L9325 lies immediately above L9336. L9336 is cut to the N by drain L9103, to the E by W9243, & to the South-Central part of the square by W9340. To the W & SW, L9336 reaches the banks.

Matrix: Medium brown soil containing numerous rocks & chunks of cement, & few tesserae. The material from L9271, at the same elevation in Square AK33, consisted of lighter, finer, & looser soil, though it also contained numerous rocks & chunks of cement likely tunable from W9003.
