Summary:

Description: Reason For Opening: when shells found in [L9328] were determined to be underneath [L9328] and constitute a separate locus.

Definition/Limits: defined by [L9328] to the North and West, by [W9140] to the East, and [L9043] to the South.

Matrix: many shells, fieldstones and large amounts of pottery possibly in situ.

Reason For Closing: not closed end of '88 season

Relation to Other Elements: [L9346] is covered by [L9328] and reaches [W9140]. [L9346] almost certainly extends

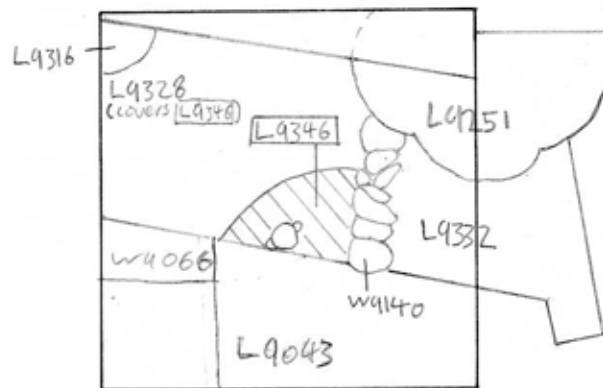
further underneath [L9328]. [L9328] could be tumble from [W9140] which would account for the <sup>large</sup> assembly of pottery suitable for restoration from [L9346] and from [L9328] above it and the numerous mortars and pestles also from [L9328]. [L9346] is also cut by [L9043].

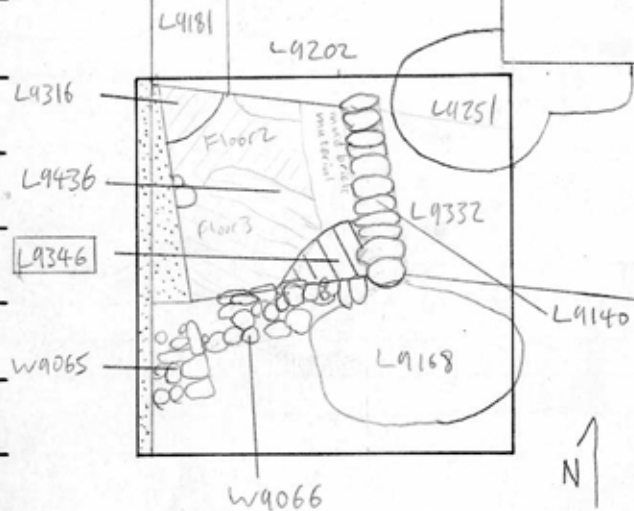
