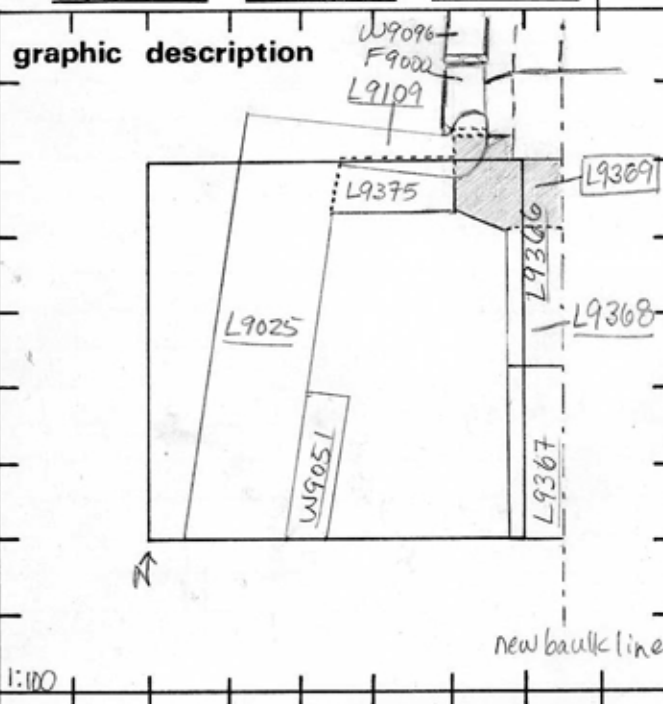

Def & Limits: To N, bordered by material below [L9109] & by baulk. To E, bounded by baulk. To S, bounded by [L9368]. To W, bordered by [L9375] and material below [L9109]

Matrix: Layer of head-size field stones resting atop fist/double-fist size stones atop grey-brown soil; soil denser in area closest to NE corner of baulk, more clay-like. Little to no pottery

Closing: End of Season - Not fully Excavated, not closed

Relations: Drain [L9109] built partly on top of [L9369] but does not extend across the whole of it, so [L9369] probably already in existence when drain [L9109] built, as a cobble-stone surface or pavement. [L9369] reached by [L9375] to W. Probably cut by RT [L9368] to S. [L9369] extends to N beneath pavement in Sq AI31 & to E of small drain spout. [L9369] lies below [L9366]
