

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Summary:

Description: Opened: To excavate material below Floor [L 9157]
 Def/Lim: North By [L 9410], [W 9065], [W 9400] + Pit [L 9168]. East By [W 9140] and Pit [L 9185], South By [L 9502] (and below), Pit [L 9414]. West By Baulk.

Matrix: Alternating layers of Brown Sandy Soil, Ashy Soil & Charcoal Ash and Plaster Floors (Very Fragmentary). Few sherds.

Closed: When [L 9380] was levelled to level of [L 9185] and materials were decided to be identical, an arbitrary ("Technical") division split [L 9380] into [L 9493], [L 9494] and [L 9501].

Relations: cut by Pits [L 9168] and [L 9185]. Reaches [W 9400], [L 9502], [L 9525]. Floor appeared to reach Stone Sole of [W 9400] though there was a gap between wall & floor (wash line).

Walls [9065] Flats on [L 9380], as does [W 9140].
 Surfaces of same deposit as [L 9380] continue in [L 9502], [L 9525], [L 9493], [L 9501], [L 9494] and [L 9411] & [L 9412] cuts [L 9502/9525] surfaces. Sump wall [W 9420] →*

[Note on Resurfacings: Due to the fragmentary and interlocking nature of these sloping surfaces, several floors were not traceable, and the one traceable floor included within this locus was deemed a resurfacing, and did not facilitate a change of locus. →
