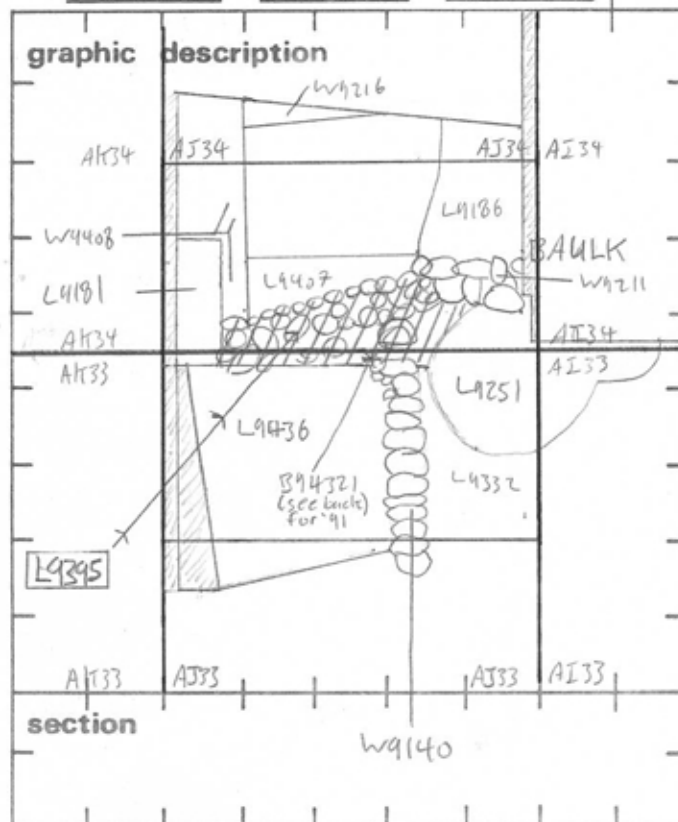

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**Summary:**

**Description:** Opened: when line of stones was recognized in L9202 and it was split into L9407 + L9395.

**Matrix:** field stones in brownish/grey soil with few shreds.

**Definition/Limits:** Defined by L9407 to the North, W9211 and L9251 to the East, L9332, W9140 and L9436 to the South, and W9408 to the Northwest.

**Reason For Closing:** not closed, end of 89 season.

**Relationship to Other Elements:** L9395 is covered by L9702. L9395 is cut by L9251. W9140 is reached by L9395, which covers the lower unexcavated courses in the North of W9140. L9395 reaches the material beneath L9436. L9395 may abut W9408 or vice versa, or it may cut W9408 or vice versa. This relationship is unclear because only the tops of each locus is exposed at the point of their relationship. Further excavation is required to ascertain their relationship.
