MATRIX: COARSE CRUMBLY DIRT WITH MORE STONES AND RUBBLE THAN REST OF SQUARE.

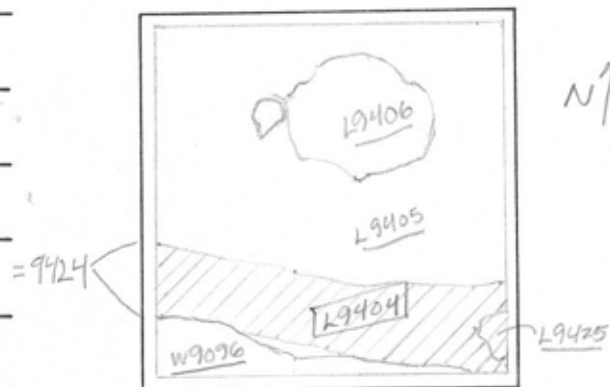
REASON FOR CLOSING: CAME DOWN ON W9425. *SEE NOTE BELOW

RELATIONS: L9404 PROBABLY CUT BY W9096. L9404 OVERLAYS L9424 AND CUTS INTO L9405. L9404 robbed, i.e. cut, W9425

*NOTE: L9425 WAS ORIGINALLY THOUGHT TO BE A WALL, BUT WAS FOUND ON 21/07/89 TO BE A CEMENT AND RUBBLE CHUNK ON TOP OF A HELLENISTIC WALL. THEREFORE THE REASON FOR CLOSING L9404 AND OPENING L9424 SHOULD BE DISREGARDED. L9425 WAS REASSIGNED

TO THE HELLENISTIC WALL.
