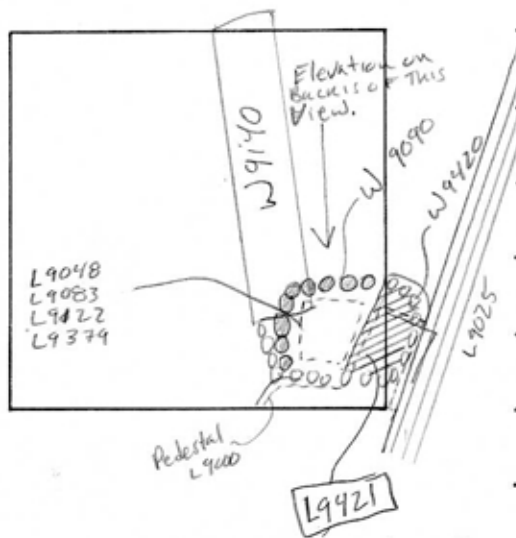

Description:

Opened to clear Fill within Ian's Sump (W9420) -

Def/lim Bounded By W9420 on North, East and South, and by Limits of Pedestal L9000 in West.

Closed when base of "Sump" wall W9420 was reached.

Matrix: Dark Brown clay/sand soil w/ few sherds and Bones.

Relations: Reaches W9420 on 3 sides. It seems that W9090 formed the West and North walls of the "Sump", but this was not realized until this season's excavation. L9379, L9122 and L9083 would all then be "Sump Fill". It is

Possible That "Possible Platform" Rubble layer L9048 formed a roof for the "Sump", creating a domed enclosure with a north facing entrance (The direction in which W9090 or W9420 do not reach the base of the "Sump". See possible plan on Back.

JZ 89: Note walls [9090] + [9420] = Sump; [9379] + [9122] + [9083] + [9421] = fill in Sump that reached both walls
