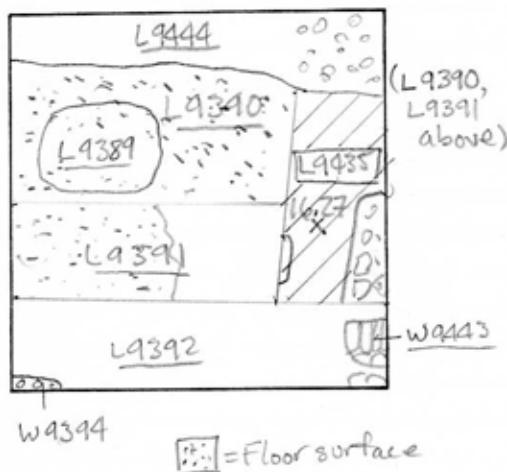

Summary:

Description: REASON FOR OPENING: CAME DOWN ON A DARK BROWN/BLACK PATCH OF SOIL RUNNING NORTH/SOUTH THROUGH L9390 AND L9391.

DEF/LIMITS: L9435 REACHES PART OF THE EAST BULK. IT ALSO BORDERS L9438 IN THE EAST. L9435 BORDERS L9444 IN THE NORTH, L9390 & L9391 IN THE WEST, AND L9392 IN THE SOUTH.

MATRIX: DARK BROWN/BLACK SOIL WITH SHERDS & SANDSTONE RUBBLE.

REASON FOR CLOSING: END OF SEASON - not closed.

RELATIONS: L9435 IS BELOW THE AREAS NOT SEALED BY FLOORS IN L9390 & L9391 AND CUTS THE FLOOR SURFACES IN BOTH OF THESE LOCI. L9435 CUTS THE RUBBLE (WALL?) OF L9438 AND POSSIBLY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DISTURBED

QUALITY OF L9438. L9435 APPEARS TO BE A ROBBERTRENCH THAT ONCE CONTAINED THE WALLS WHICH ENCLOSED THE HYPOTHESIZED ROOM WHOSE FLOORS ARE FOUND IN L9389, L9390, L9391, L9435. L9435 CONTAINS A LARGE WORKED STONE IN ITS WEST EDGE THOUGH ITS PURPOSE IS UNKNOWN (POSSIBLY PART OF WALL?). ROBBERTRENCH L9435 APPEARS TO BE CONTEMPORARY WITH TWO OTHER ROBBERTRENCHES L9444 IN THE NORTH AND L9392 IN THE SOUTH. THESE THREE R.T.'S ARE LIKELY TO HAVE CONTAINED THE WALLS FOR THE HYPOTHESIZED ROOM.
